    - 1) Determine whether to schedule student disciplinary hearings and authorize use of hearing officers
    - 2) Second-level Appeal of Long Term Suspension
    - 3) Consideration of scheduling a request to readmit a permanently expelled student
  - B. Personnel issues pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.03 (A)(1); legal advice/instruction to attorney pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.03 Subsections (A)(3) and (A)(4)
    - 1) Administrative appointments, reassignments and transfers
    - 2) Recommendations to deny requests for leave of absence
    - 3) Withdraw a Notice of Intent to Dismiss and Accept Teacher Resignation
    - 4) Statement of Charges and Resolution to Send Notice of Intent to Dismiss Certificated Teacher, and determine whether to appoint hearing officer to conduct teacher dismissal hearing pursuant to A.R.S. §15-541
  - C. Legal advice/instruction to attorney pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.03 Subsections (A)(3) and (A)(4); negotiations pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.03 Subsection (A)(5); and personnel issues pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.03 (A)(1)
    - 1) Discussions or consultations with designated representatives of the Governing Board in order to consider its position and instruct its representatives regarding negotiations with employee organizations
    - 2) Personnel Matters
