- Manuscript and Cursive standards added.

Two types of Writing

- Manuscript
 - Writing that consists of un-joined letters made with lines and circles. Often taught at the elementary level.
 - Grades K-2
- Cursive
 - Writing with strokes of successive characters joined together.
 - Grades 3-5
