Technology Justification

The use of technology is altering the way that teachers are teaching and (all) students are learning. Each TUSD Communication Media Technology teacher has received the following technology and training. This purchase would allow for continued device compatibility and future instructional enhancements.

- 12.9 iPad Pro which enables them to be mobile in the classroom with the ability to monitor/control student's machines on the iPad with software only available from Apple.
- 3-day training using Adobe Master Collection with iMacs.
- Apple TV to enable students and teachers to share/collaborate projects currently on workstation or iPad
- Classroom sets of iPads so students can learn how to quickly edit clip or picture shot with iPad and share it immediately back to desktop with Apple's airdrop technology.

Justification of Purchase

- This Purchase is part of CTE refresh schedule to replace current aging Apple iMacs being used in CTE Photo and CMT labs with newest iMac in order to make program compatible enhancements.
- CTE IT staff will have the ability to continue to remotely manage, track and deploy Apps to all Apple devices including the ability to restrict what apps can be used. Purchasing another device would mean that each machine would have to be touched individually based on program needs.
- We are also planning to refresh aging desktops in CTE Early Childhood Development programs with iPads. The mobile devices will allow for technology expansion at a later date. This purchase will also allow us to manage the devices more efficiently, using an already existing system.
