TITLE: Award Invitation for Bids (IFB) 17-43-C18 - Sabino High School Roof Replacement

PURPOSE:

To approve the award of IFB 17-43-C18 for the Sabino High School Roof Replacement. The project is expected to be funded by the Arizona School Facilities Board (SFB).

DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

It is the intention of the Tucson Unified School District to re-roof Sabino High School.

IFB 17-43-C18 was posted to www.azpurchasing.org TUSD's official bid board. Notice was sent to four-hundred eleven (411) vendors, TUSD received five (5) bids and one-hundred five (105) "NO BIDS".

The submitted bid documents were forwarded to the contract liaison and TUSD's contracted architectural firm, Herzog and Associates. Both agreed that the submitted pricing per categories were considered fair and reasonable. After careful review, the following bids are being considered responsive and responsible; Gryphon Companies, Inc., Roofing Southwest, Sun Valley Builders, LLC, and United Builders, LLC. JBS Roofing is not being considered due to not providing a system as specified within the Architect's Plans and Specifications and is therefore determined "non-responsive."

Of the four (4) vendors determined to be responsive and responsible, Roofing Southwest's bid pricing was lowest for both bid packages of this IFB. This determination is in accordance with AZ. Administrative Code R7-2-1031, subsection C, Bid Evaluation and Award. The District contracted architect, Herzog and Associates, and the TUSD Architecture & Engineering Program Manager recommended award to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, Roofing Southwest.

Estimated expenditures are: Bid package 1 for \$1,042,524.00 and bid package 2 for \$1,418,642.00. Both package combined totals are expected to be \$2,461,166.00. A 10% contingency could bring the potential spend of this project to approximately \$2.7 million.

All expenses are expected to be reimbursed by the Arizona Schools Facilitates Board.

Award recommendation is to Roofing Southwest.

An Executive Summary and the department's award recommendation are attached for Governing Board review.

Pat Cisneros, Program Manager for Architecture & Engineering will be present to answer questions regarding this project. Kevin Startt, Director of Purchasing, will be present to answer questions regarding the procurement process.
