PURPOSE:

The Impact Aid application process requires the District Governing Board to review and approve its Indian Policies and Procedures annually, no earlier than February 1st.

DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Impact Aid is a federal formula grant program designed to assist local school districts that have 1) lost property tax revenue due to the presence of tax-exempt federal property (examples would include Tribal lands such as casinos, military property such as DMAFB, and federal property such as the VA Hospital, correctional facilities, courthouses, mines or national parks) or 2) experienced increased expenditures due to the enrollment of federally connected children.
