



Why should students want to study critical languages?

- United State Department identifies two C.L.: Mandarin Chinese and Arabic
- Present budget cuts, federal government funding C.L. programs
- Learning a critical language like Arabic can open up doors for students
- Arabic provides opportunities for university-bound students:
 - scholarships and programs open to those who have completed 2 years of high school Arabic
 - Foreign Language and Area Studies (FLAS) fellowships for students who are U.S. citizens
- Military interests:
 - Project GO (Global Officers), U of A ROTC students to learn Arabic (http://cmes.arizona.edu/projectgo)
 - Non-ROTC students through our new Flagship program (http://menas.arizona.edu/featured/flagship)
 - Similar programs exist at many out-of-state universities.
