After School Pilot Programs

- Banks, Ford, Howell, Hudlow, Lynn, McCorkle: Parent Forums & Email Communique
- Unlicensed
- ▶ \$25 a week
- ► Low enrollment: range from 20-26 students

Next Steps

- Early Registration for 2019-20 SY
- Increase tuition from \$25 to \$40 a week
- License program to accept DES
- Meet Minimum enrollment requirements by August 31st to continue program or recommend closure (Parent Communication)
- ► If closure: offer families options at other sites (buses), facilitate partnership with KIDCO or other after school options, offer information about other neighborhood after school care programs.

Oyama and Marshall Preschool

- Oyama:
 - -increase enrollment from 11 students to minimum of 16 students.
 - -currently at 15 students
- Marshall
 - -increase enrollment from 10 students to minimum of 16 students

Next Steps:

- Early Registration for SY 19-20
- Promotion of programs/site lead recruitment
- Meet Minimum enrollment requirements by August 31st to continue program or recommend closure (Parent Communication)
- If closure: offer placement at other nearby tuition programs
