TITLE:	Approval of Invitation for Bids (IFB) 17-45-C17 New Bus Lease to Purchase

PURPOSE:

It is the intention of the Tucson Unified School District to lease to purchase 30 new buses. There are two (2) different bus models being solicited under this bid. TUSD Operations plans to purchase twenty-one (21) 72 passenger buses and nine (9) 36 passenger special needs buses. Buses must be delivered to The Tucson Unified School District Transportation Department, no later than July 28, 2017.

DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

IFB 17-45-C17 was posted to www.azpurchasing.org TUSD's official bid board. Notice was sent to one-hundred six (106) vendors. TUSD received four (4) bids and thirty-three (33) "NO BIDS".

The submitted bid documents were reviewed by the TUSD Transportation Contract Liaison, Ken Bolle, along with the TUSD Procurement Agent, Kevin Oster. After careful review, all bids are being considered responsive and responsible; Auto Safety House, Canyon State Bus Sales, RWC International and Transportation Services Co (TSC). An abstract was created based on all bid pricings that were submitted for both vehicle types. It has been determined that TSC Inc. submitted bid pricing which was lowest for both vehicle requirements of this IFB.

It has been determined that under A.A.C. R7-2-1031, subsection C that this vendor is the single lowest responsible and responsive bidder for all materials or services under this IFB. Award recommendation is to Transportation Services Company (TSC Co.)

Estimated expenditures for 21 each 72 Passenger buses is \$2,058,070.56 and 9 each 36 Passenger buses is \$924,417.36. Both vehicles combined totals is expected to be \$2,982,487.92 excluding taxes. It is the intent to finance lease these 30 buses through Ally Bank, who is partnering with TSC. Inc. to provide financing under this IFB. The amount to be financed through Ally Bank is \$3,149,507.24 at a rate of 2.54% (\$661,890.33 Yr. X 5). Total expenditures including tax and interest over the five year period is estimated to be \$3,309,452.

An Executive Summary, Department Award Recommendation and Proposed Amortization are attached for the Governing Board to review.

Stuart Duncan, Chief Operations Officer will be present to answer questions regarding this project. Kevin Startt, Director of Purchasing, will be present to answer questions regarding the procurement process.
