Both the agenda and the meeting notice will be posted at least 24 hours prior to the meeting except in case of an actual emergency or a recessed and resumed meeting as described in A.R.S. 38-431.02(D) (E). The notices will be posted in English and in Spanish on the TUSD website and in the posting cabinet at the front door of the TUSD administrative office. Board Agenda Information Process

- A Governing Board packet will be available for public review by 10 a.m. the day
 prior to the board meeting and will continue to be available during regular
 business hours until the start of the meeting. Agendas and packets are subject
 to change up to 24 hours prior to the Governing Board meeting.
- In accordance with a public records request, copies of materials may be obtained pursuant to Board Policy #1150/KDB – Public Information/ Public's Right to Know – Freedom of Information.
- Questions regarding board meeting agendas or materials may be directed to the Director of Staff Services, who will forward them to the Board President and Superintendent, or copy them on any replies, as appropriate.

Order of Business

Unless the Board votes otherwise at a previous meeting, the order of business at each meeting shall be as listed below; however the Board President can reorder the items with a section at any time before the meeting begins. Any such changes should be announced at the start of the meeting. After the meeting begins, the agreed to by a majority of Board members present at each meeting, the order of business shall be as listed on an agendaBoard may vote, at any time, to reorder items within or across sections.
