TITLE: Approval and Commitment of Funding for Continuation of District Internet and Long Distance Services for School

#### **PURPOSE:**

To approve funding for the continuation of the following services for the District during the 2013-2014 school year:

- 1. Internet service pursuant to the existing contract with Login
- 2. Long-distance telephone service pursuant to the existing contract with CenturyLink

#### **DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION:**

District Internet service is currently provided under a multi-term contract with Login and long-distance telephone service is currently provided under a multi-term contract with CenturyLink. Both services are eligible for a district-wide discount of approximately 81% through the federal E-rate program. In order to receive this discount for the 2013-2014 school year, TUSD must submit an E-rate application for these services by March 14, 2013 and certify that the District has committed the funding required to pay the non-discount portion of approximately 19%.

Should the Board choose to approve this item, it would consist of the following for the 2013-2014 school year:

- A continuation of existing Internet service with Login and long-distance telephone service with CenturyLink for an annual total cost of approximately **\$176,987**.
- A commitment of the funding required to pay TUSD's share of the total cost, which will be approximately \$33,628.

The costs for this item can be summarized as follows:

<sup>\*</sup> The cost for Login reflects an increase in speed from 800 Mbps (\$10,028/mo) to 1000 Mbps (\$13,500/mo) plus a one-time non-recurring charge of \$300 for every 50 Mbps increase (\$1,200).

The District will be required to pay the full monthly cost for Internet and long-distance telephone services until the E-rate application is approved. Once approved, TUSD will receive a reimbursement for E-rate's

share of the cost.

This supports the Superintendent's Goals of achievement, student enrollment and customer service.
