

Targeted Learning Tutoring Sessions School Year 2017-2018

Clarifying Information



Please note: Targeted Learning Tutoring Sessions MUST start Monday January 8th, 2018

Pay for Targeted Learning Sessions:

The Targeted Learning Sessions stipend amount is prorated by the dates the assigned teachers work from January 8th through April 1st.

Calculation:

The stipend is calculated by multiplying the teacher's Daily Rate by 57 days, multiplied by 20%. The stipend amount is divided and distributed by the pay periods in that timeframe. Please see example below.

Teacher is on STEP 21 of the TDR(A) Salary Schedule

STEP 21 = \$42,300 (this does not include the supplemental pay, base only)

Number of work days = 207

Daily Rate = \$204.35 (\$42,300/207)

17-18 Targeted Learning Stipend = 57 days (paid workdays between January 8th and April 1st)

 $57 \times \$204.35 = \$11,647.95$

 $$11,647.95 \times 20\% = $2,329.59$

Stipend = \$2,329.59 (estimated)

Absences:

If the assigned teacher is absent on a given day and a designee covers the group, there is no compensation for designee.

Student Selection:

As you identify students for the Targeted Learning Sessions please consider the following:

- Students that are on the "cusp" list provided to administrators by Dr. Freitas.
- Students benchmark scores. Second quarter cut scores will be completed on Thursday December 21st at the close of the Benchmark window. First quarter scores can be used.
- Student grades. Which students are close to passing or just passing that may benefit from the extra support?
- Teacher recommendation. Teachers may recommend students that would benefit from the extra support to learn content and pass AzMERIT.
- Please remember to keep in mind that students must have good attendance and behavior.
- All classes should have a minimum of 15 students and NO more than 20.

Elementary (K-8) Attendance:

Please take attendance by using excel sheet attached.

Grades and Synergy:

- ALL students (middle school and high school) will receive a letter grade (not a pass/fail).
- Withdraw selected students effective 12/21/2017 (this date is important—please verify after entering)
 - o For grades 6-8, withdraw student from appropriate elective
 - o For High School, withdraw student from PE
- Create sections for AzMERIT Interventions
 - o Term should be Quarter 3
 - o For High School: use course 15113 (Response to Intervention) for both ELA and Math.
 - o For Middle Schools:
 - for ELA use 45107 (Academic Literacy)
 - for Math use 43642 (Math Intervention)
- For students, start date in intervention class should be 01/08/2018 (End date should be left blank).
