

RESOLUTION REGARDING BUDGETARY PROVISIONS AFFECTING SCHOOL DISTRICTS

WHEREAS, the proposed Arizona state budget for FY 2015-16 includes substantial cuts to District Additional Assistance and JTED/school district funding formulas. It also mandates an increase in classroom spending without funding that increase, thus essentially mandating reductions to important instructional support programs including counselors, speech therapists, audiologists, teacher trainers, curriculum and special education directors, custodial services, and transportation;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the TUSD Governing Board opposes any further reductions to funding for Arizona public school districts, including but not limited to those provisions in the Governor's budget which result in a net reduction of funding for school district programming.
