DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION:  Pima County to provide training, nursing services and provide the immunizations, pursuant to A.R.S. 36-673(C), TUSD may hold site-based clinics to administer immunizations to school-aged children attending District schools to improve immunization compliance as required by law for school attendance. It has been demonstrated that compliance is enhanced by school site immunizations. School site clinics help prevent suspension for non-compliance as mandated by state law.
