School Consolidation Plan

- Boundary changes
 - 3411 Letters sent home to students impacted
 - Individualized letters included boundary information and all available school choices
 - Parents asked to indicate school choice option and return

- Enrollment
 - Approximately 2000 letters with school selections have been received so far
 - By March 23 all records of students impacted by closure and boundary changes will be set in Mojave
 - Contact is being made with parents that did not respond

- Transition Management
 - Support planning workshops held for closing schools and receiving school Transition
 Teams on March 13th & 14th
 - Closing School Support meetings being held with all staff at sites as requested
 - Activities and events are being planned such as pen pals, site visits, joint summer school, parent meetings, open house...



- School Consolidation Newsletter on 3rd edition and website is full of information
- HR team is meeting site by site with second visits to each site, certified placements start March 25th
- Program Placements Set
- The Special Master has forwarded projects for approval to the Desegregation Judge

- 90% of technology inventory completed
