

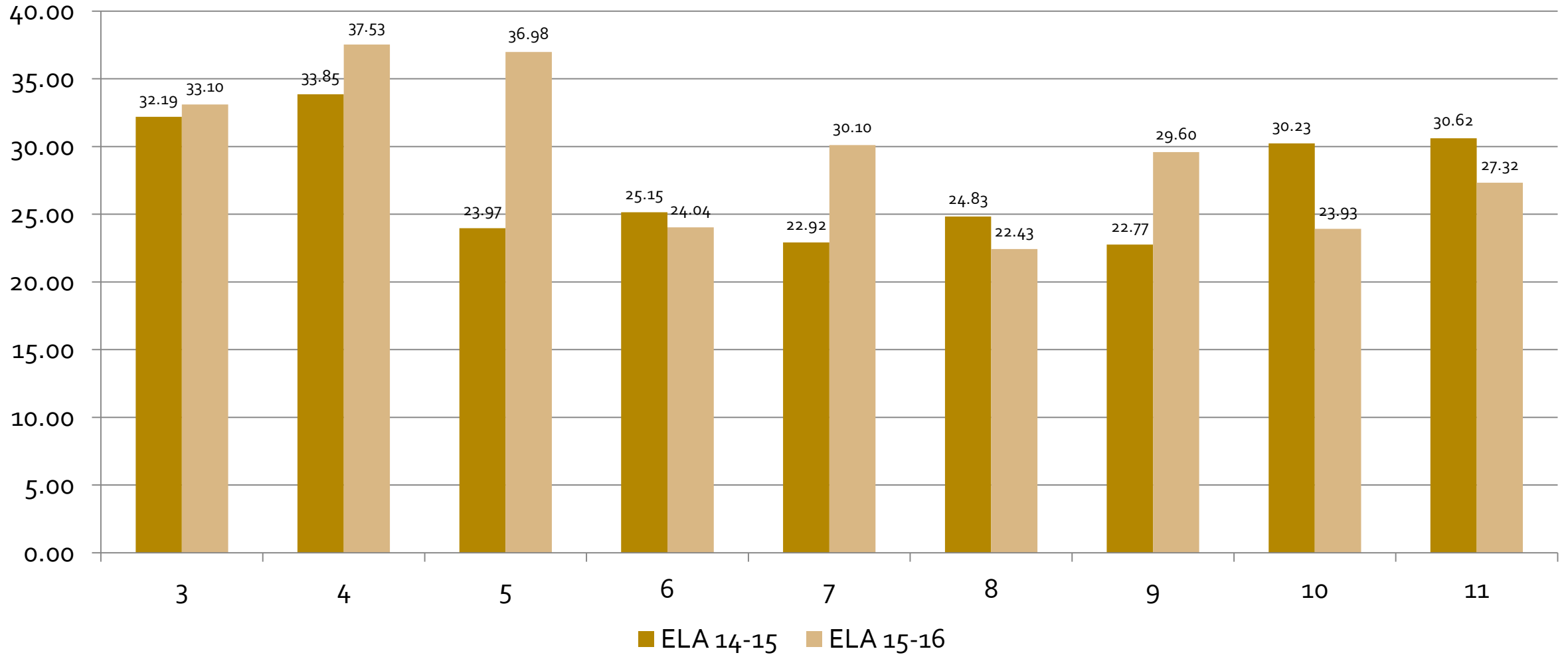

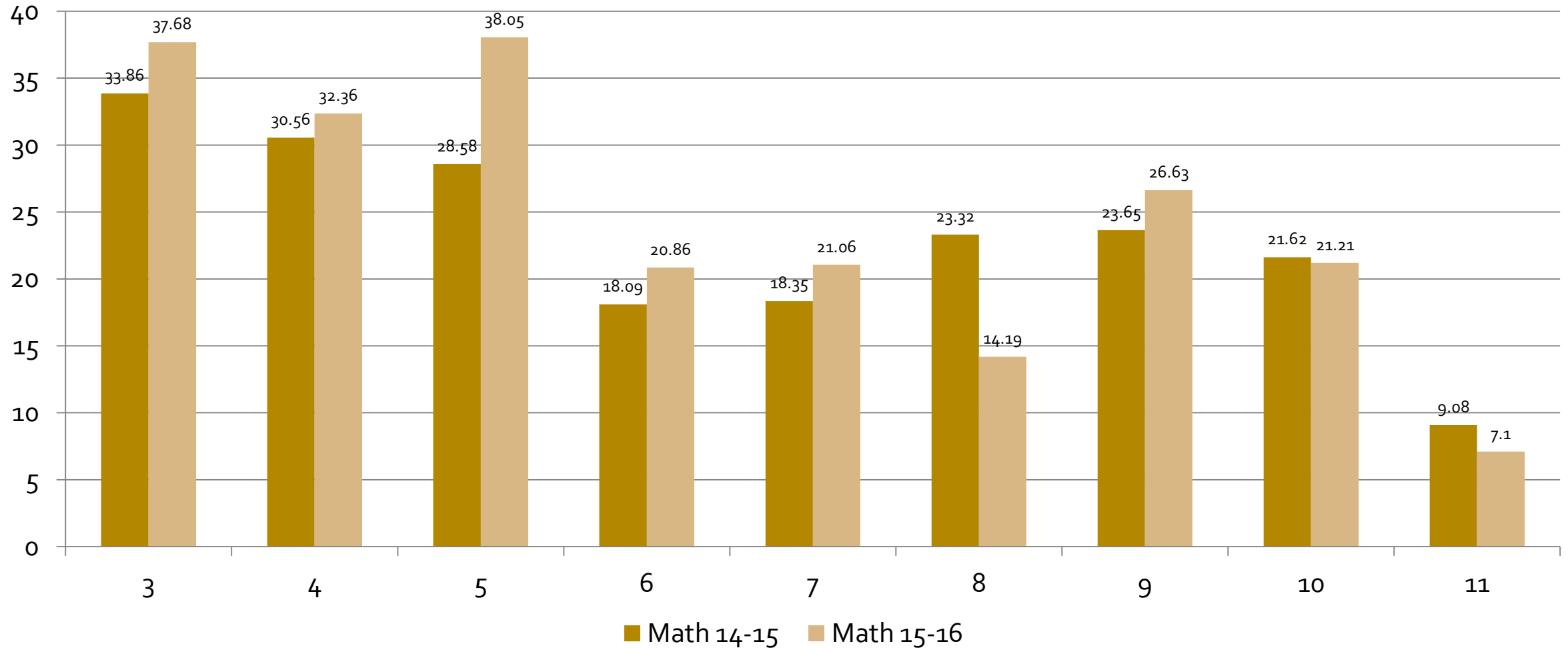

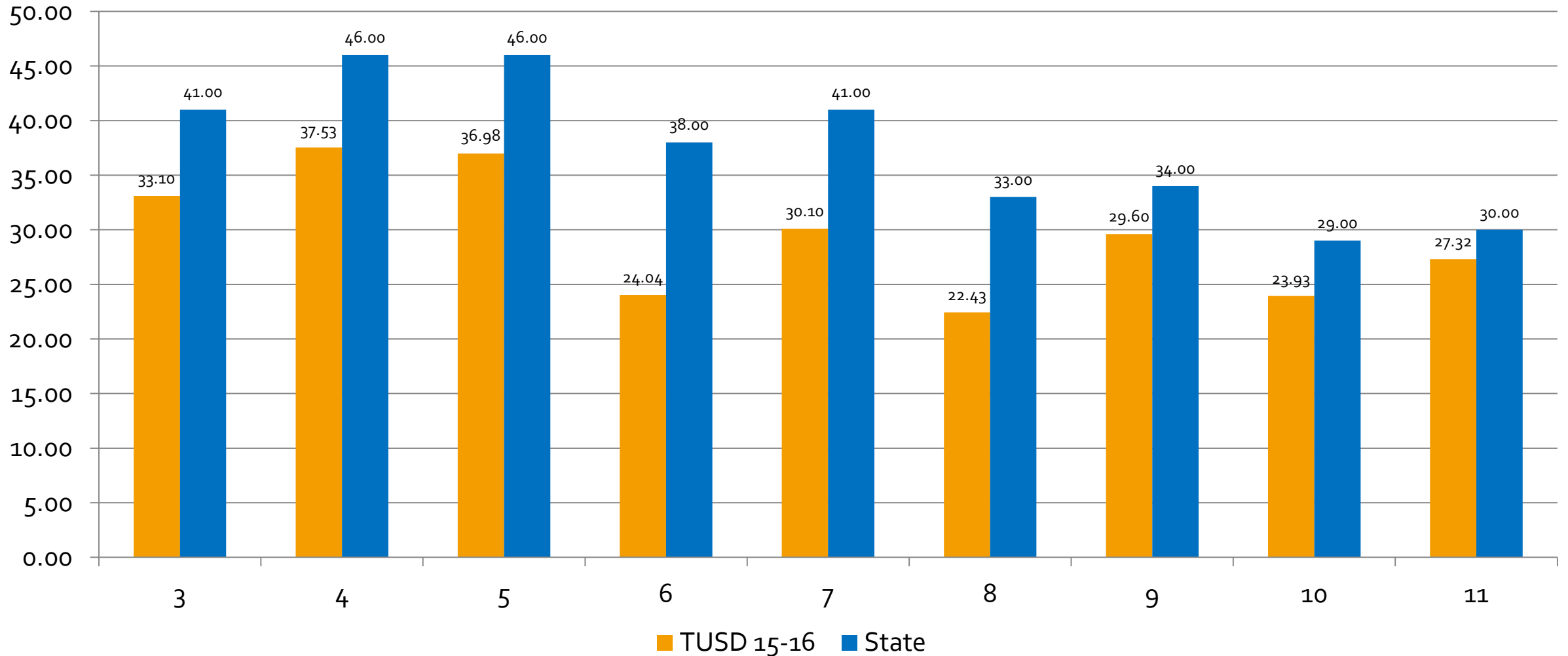
Two Year Comparison by Grade of ELA Percent Proficiency on AzMERIT (2015 to 2016)



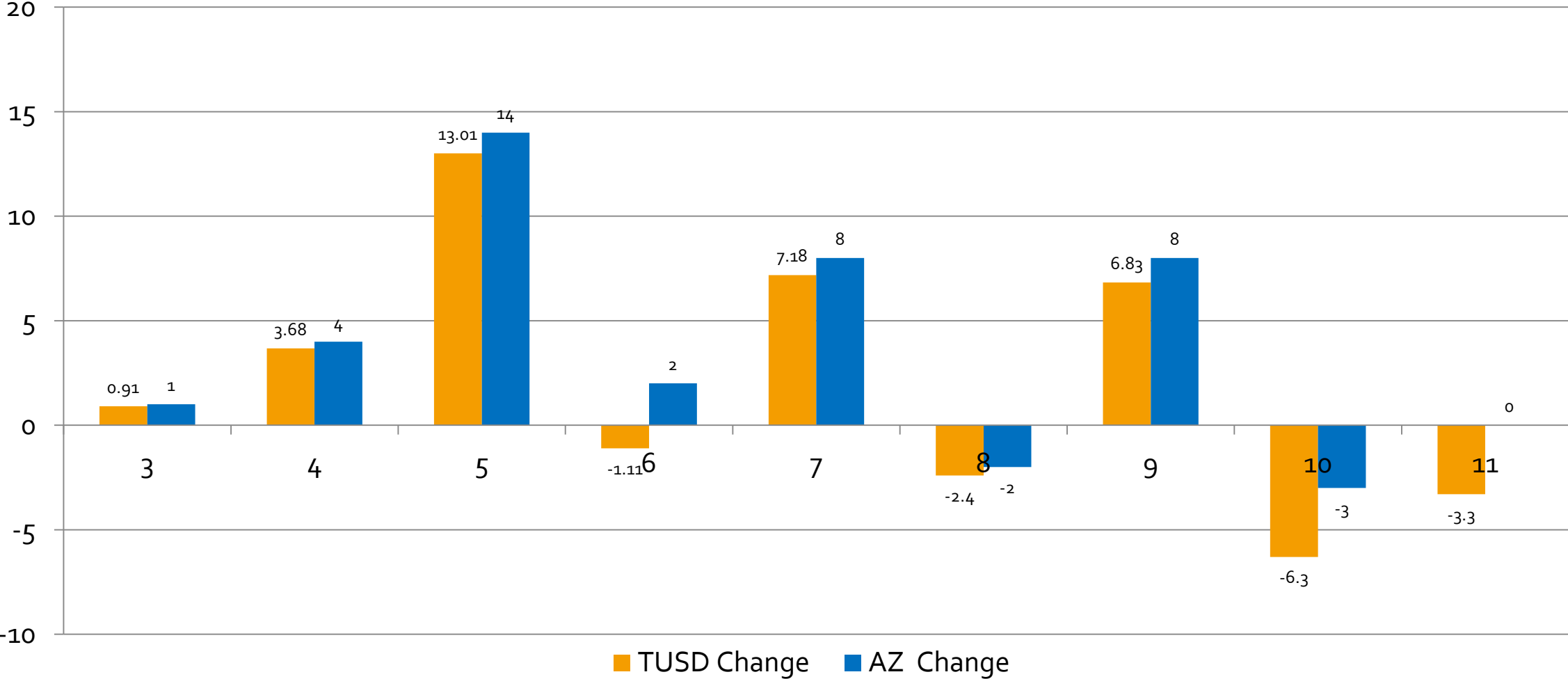
Two Year Comparison of MATH by Grade of Percent Proficiency on AzMERIT (2015 to 2016)



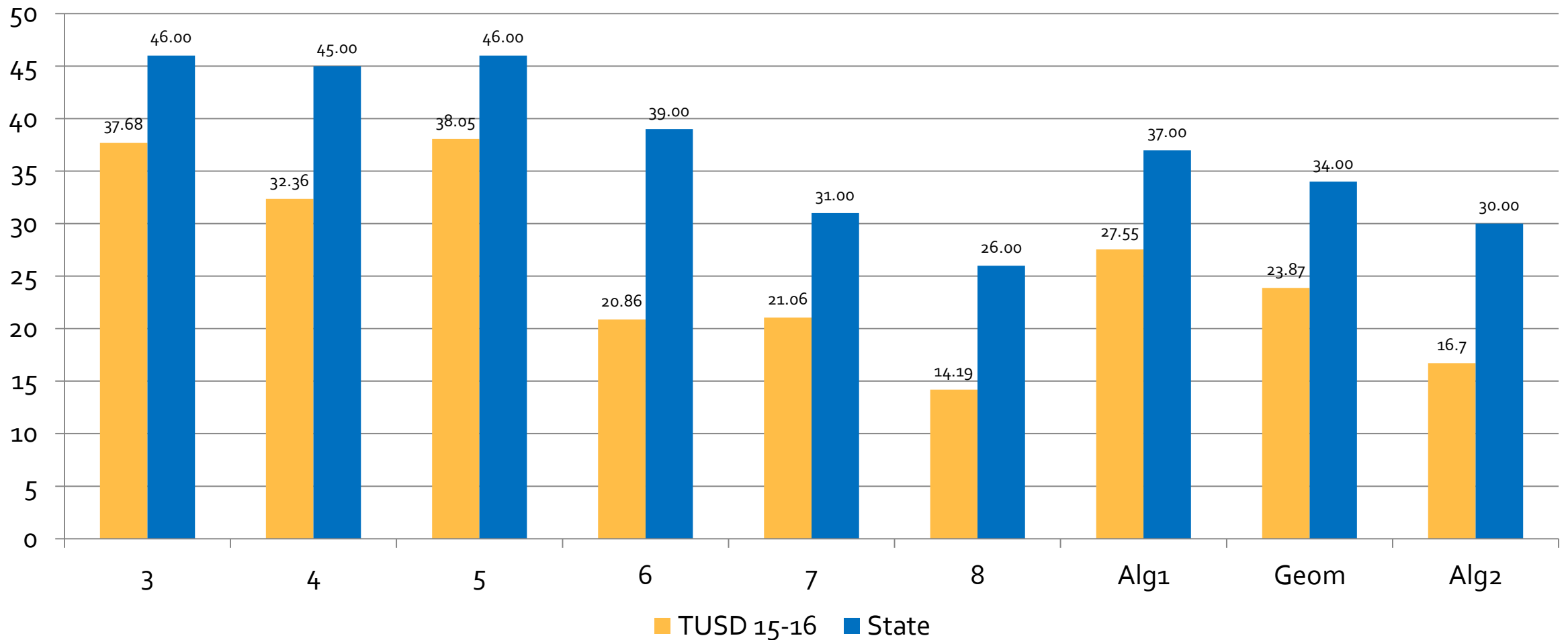
TUSD AzMERIT 2016 ELA Percent Proficient by Grade Compared to the State of AZ



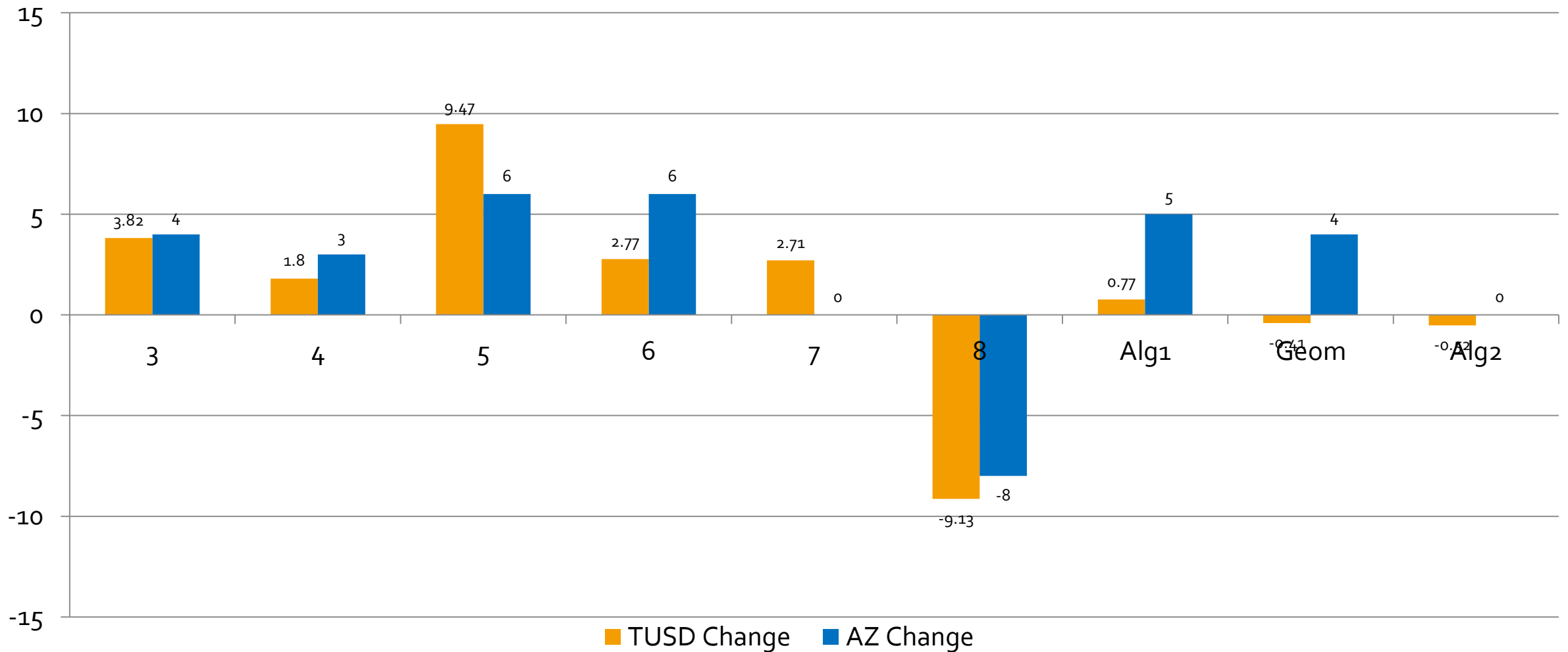
Comparison of TUSD and State of AZ – ELA Percent Proficiency Change over 2 Years



TUSD AzMERIT 2016 MATH Percent Proficient by Grade Compared to the State of AZ

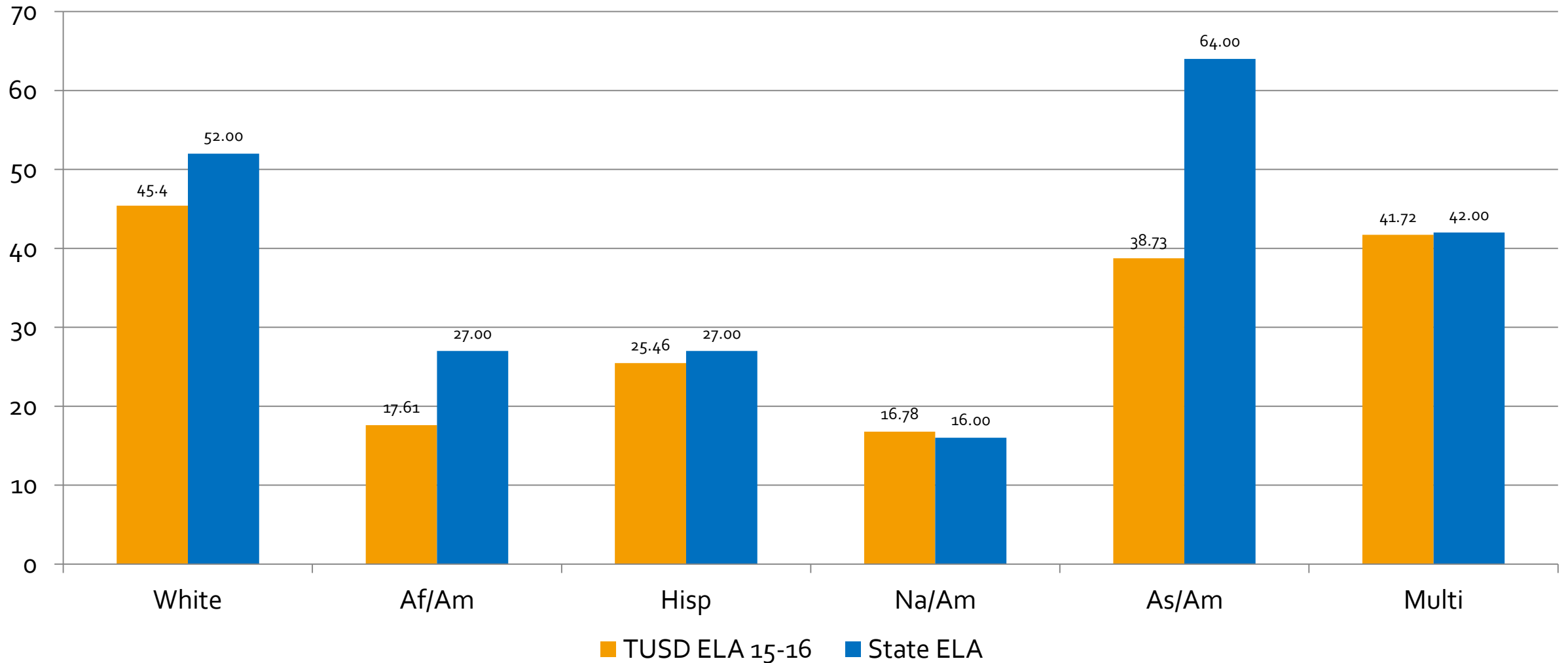


Comparison of TUSD and State of AZ – MATH Percent Proficiency Change over 2 Years



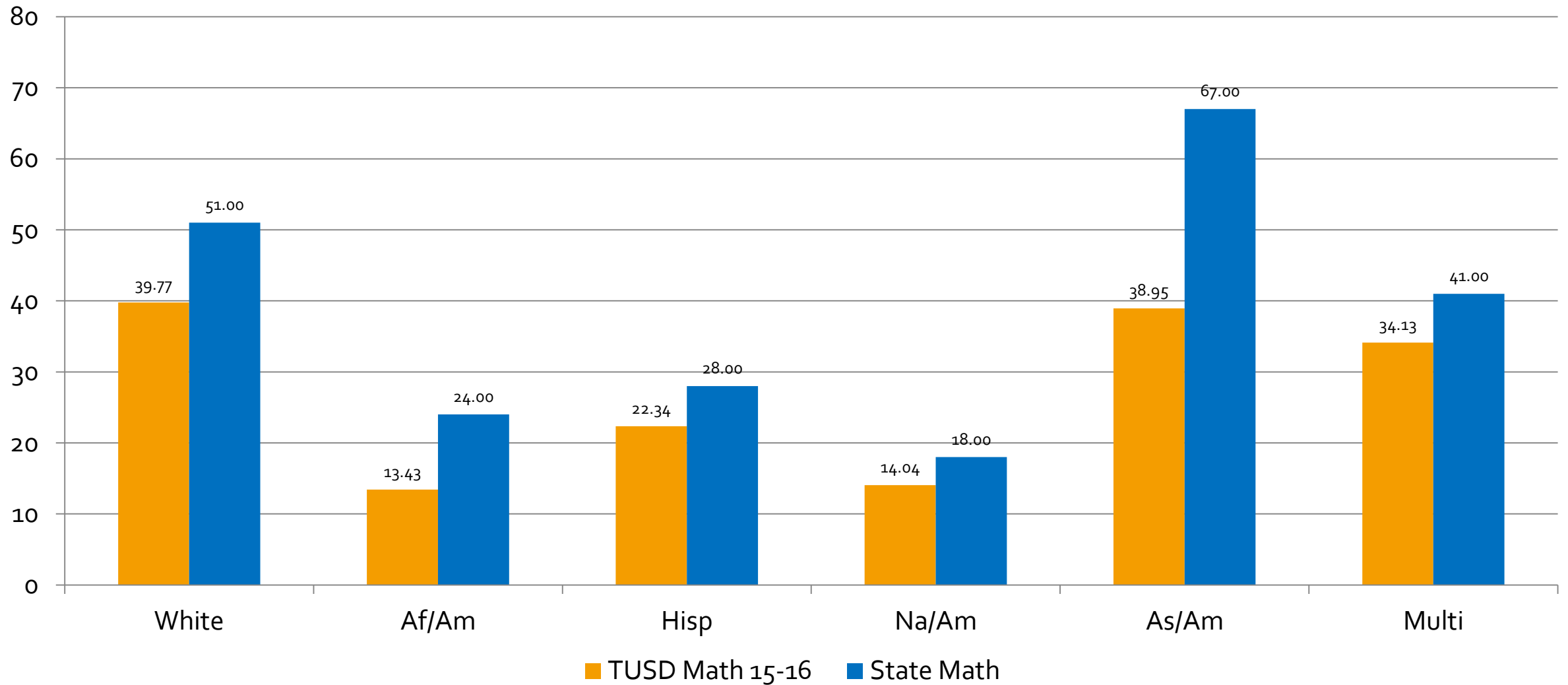

AzMERIT 2016 Percent Proficiency by Ethnicity

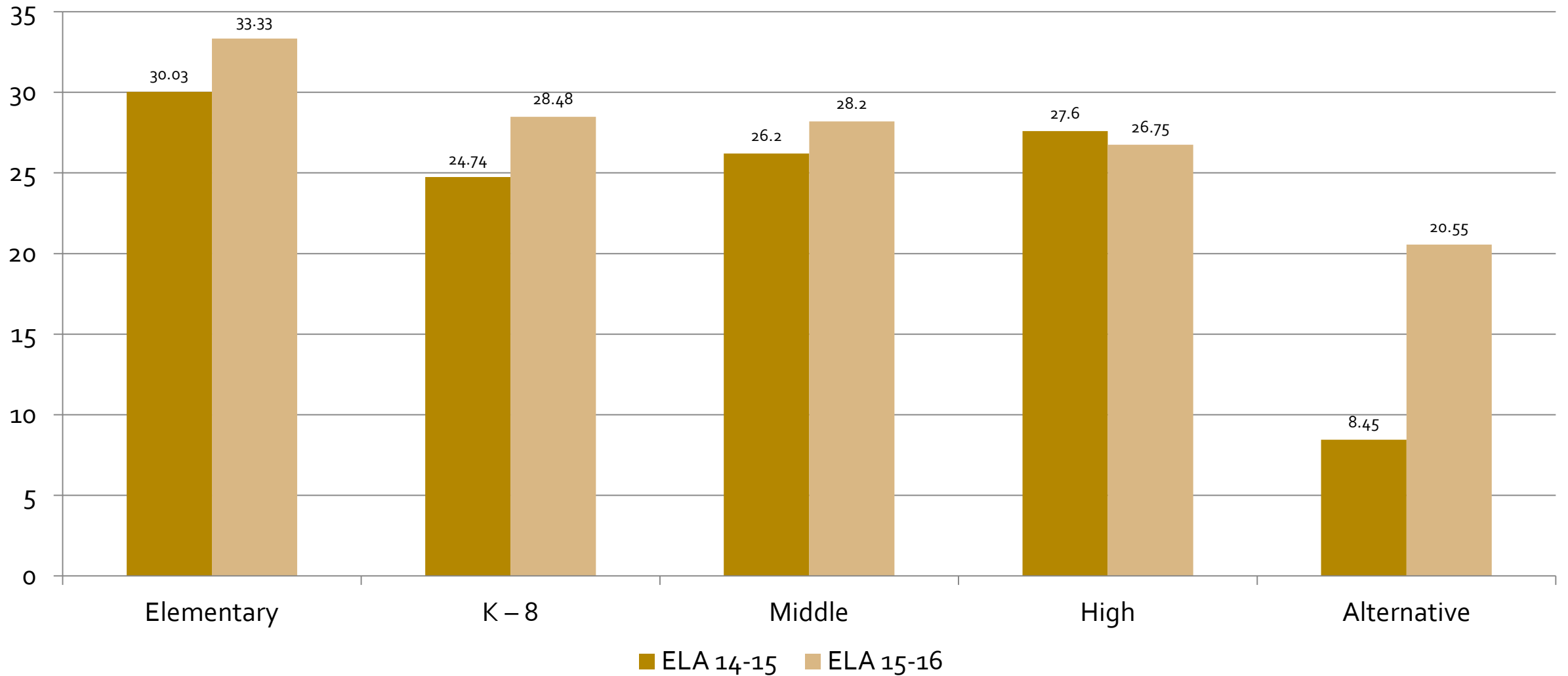

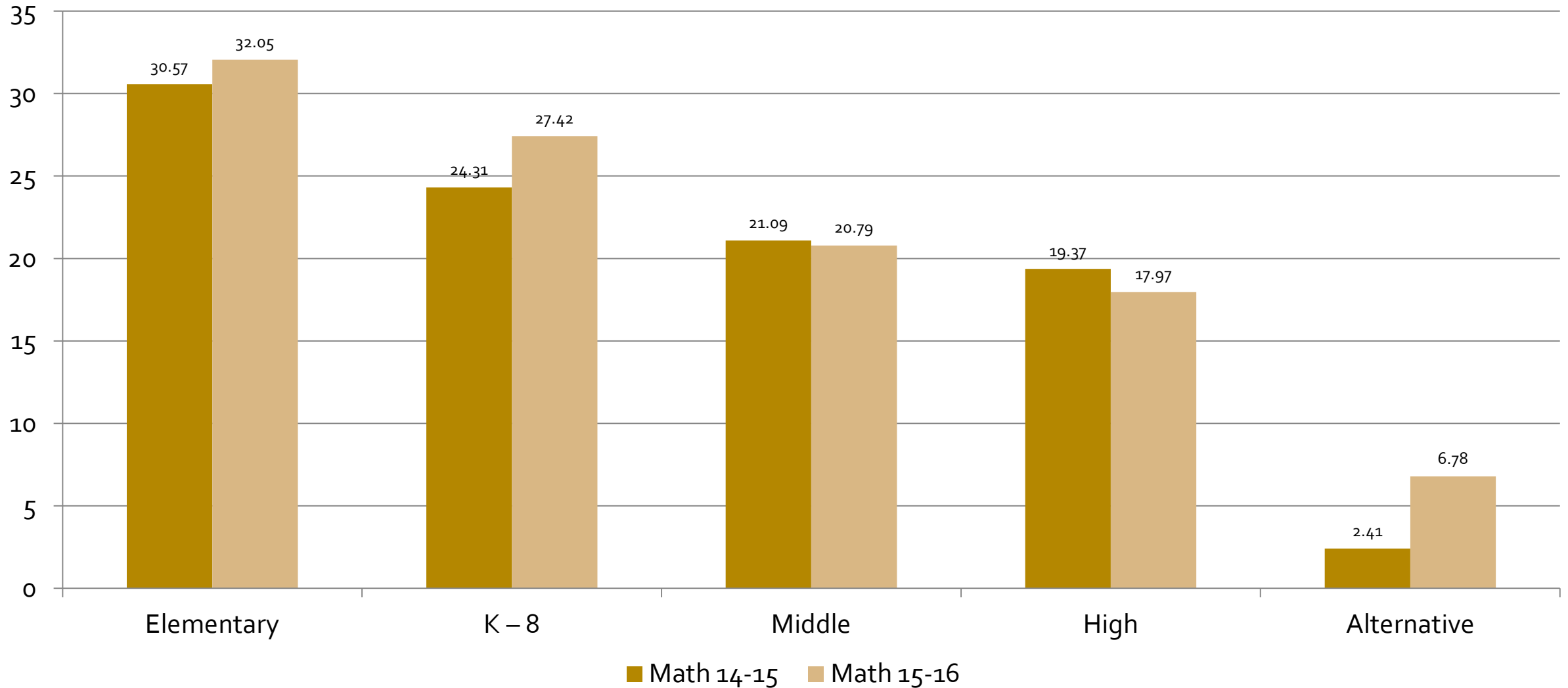

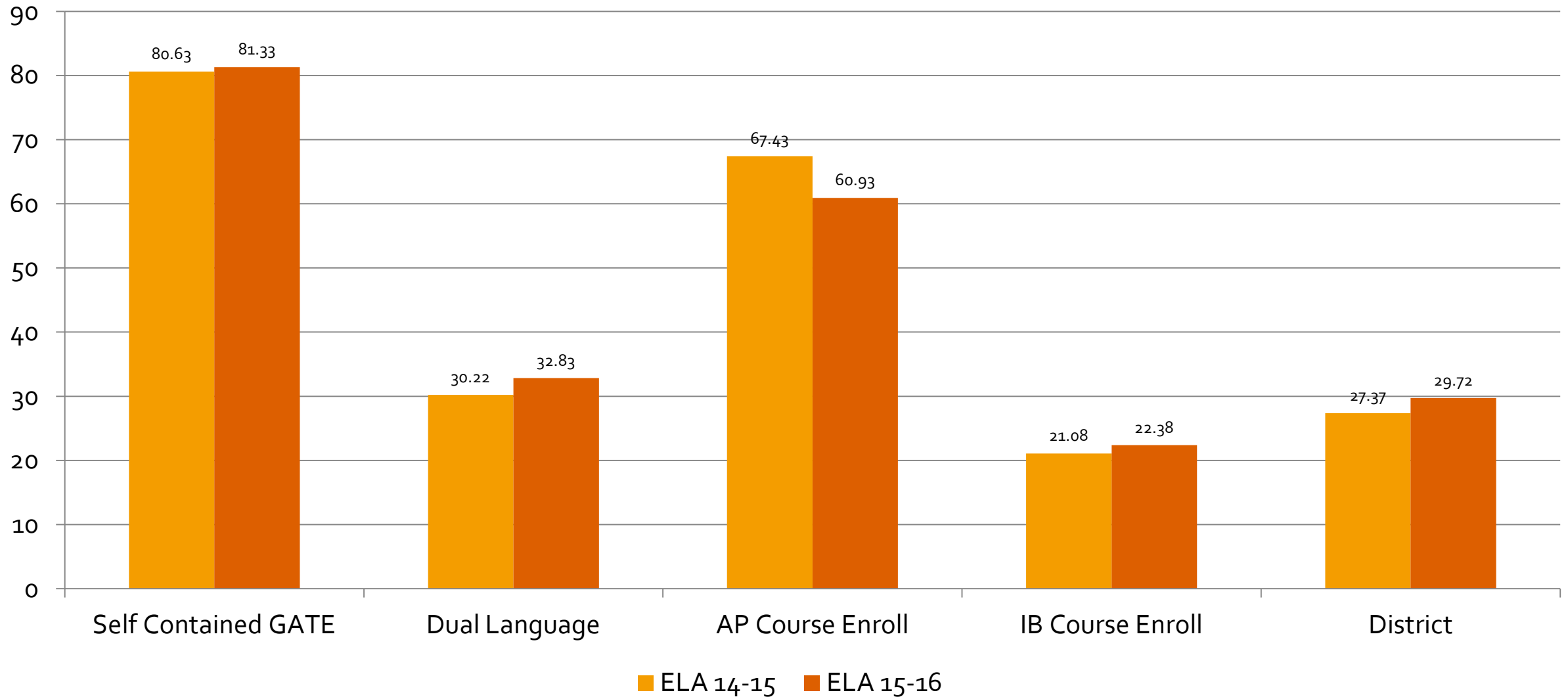
TUSD Grade Level Comparison of AzMERIT ELA Percent Proficiency over 2 Years (2015 to 2016)



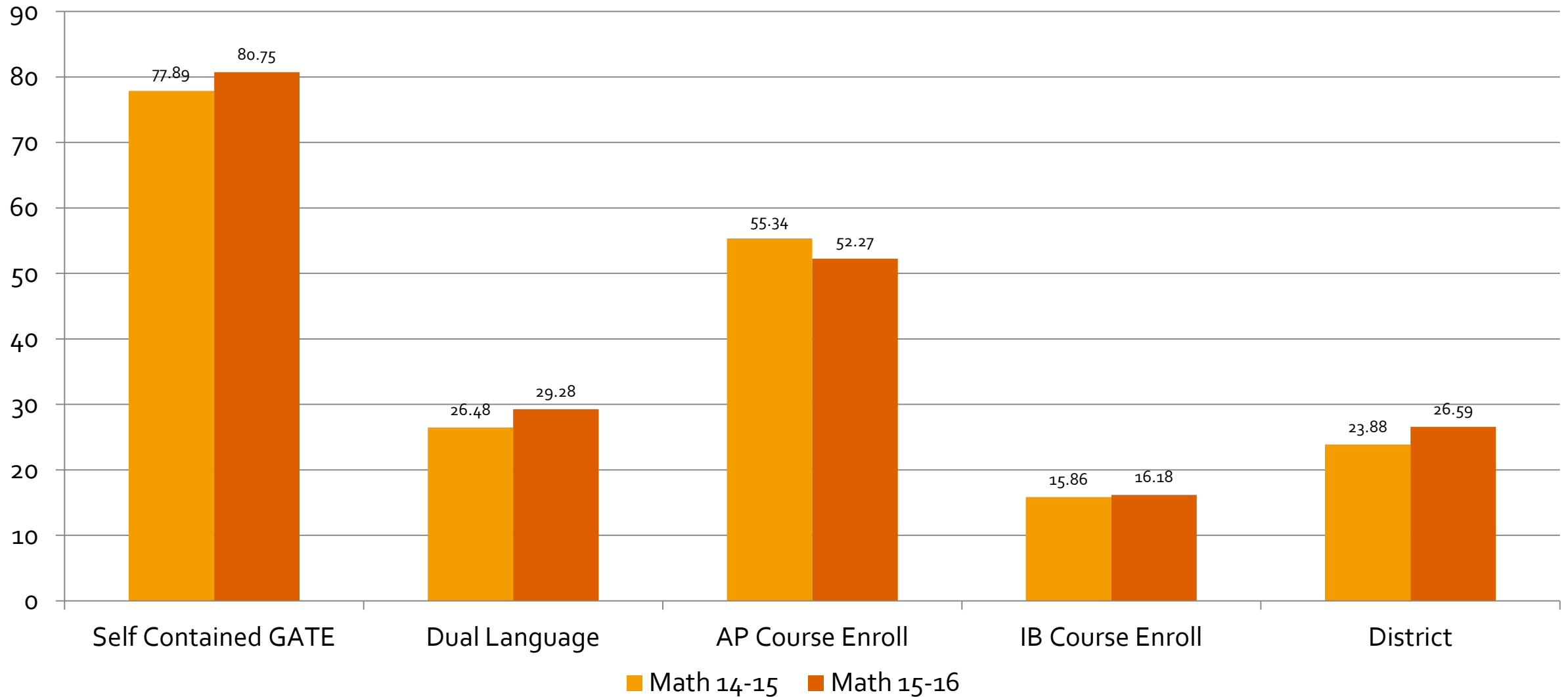
TUSD Grade Level Comparison of AzMERIT MATH Percent Proficiency over 2 Years (2015 to 2016)



TUSD ALE Programs Comparison of AzMERIT ELA Percent Proficiency over 2 Years (2015 to 2016) Grades 3 - 11

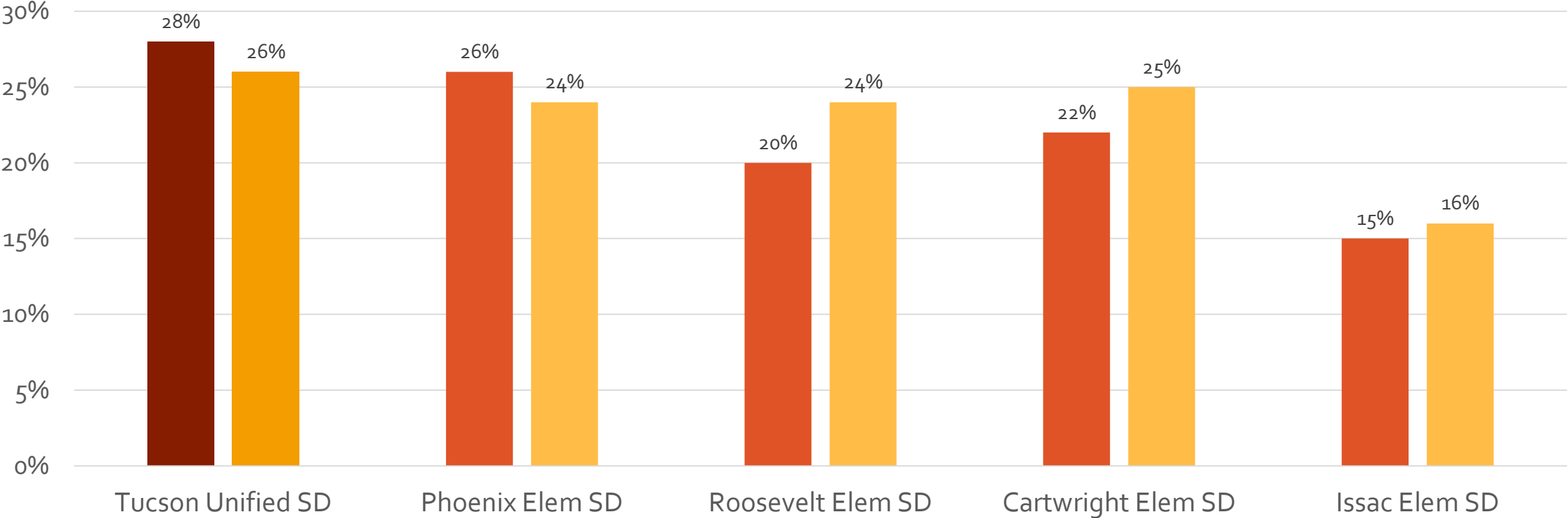

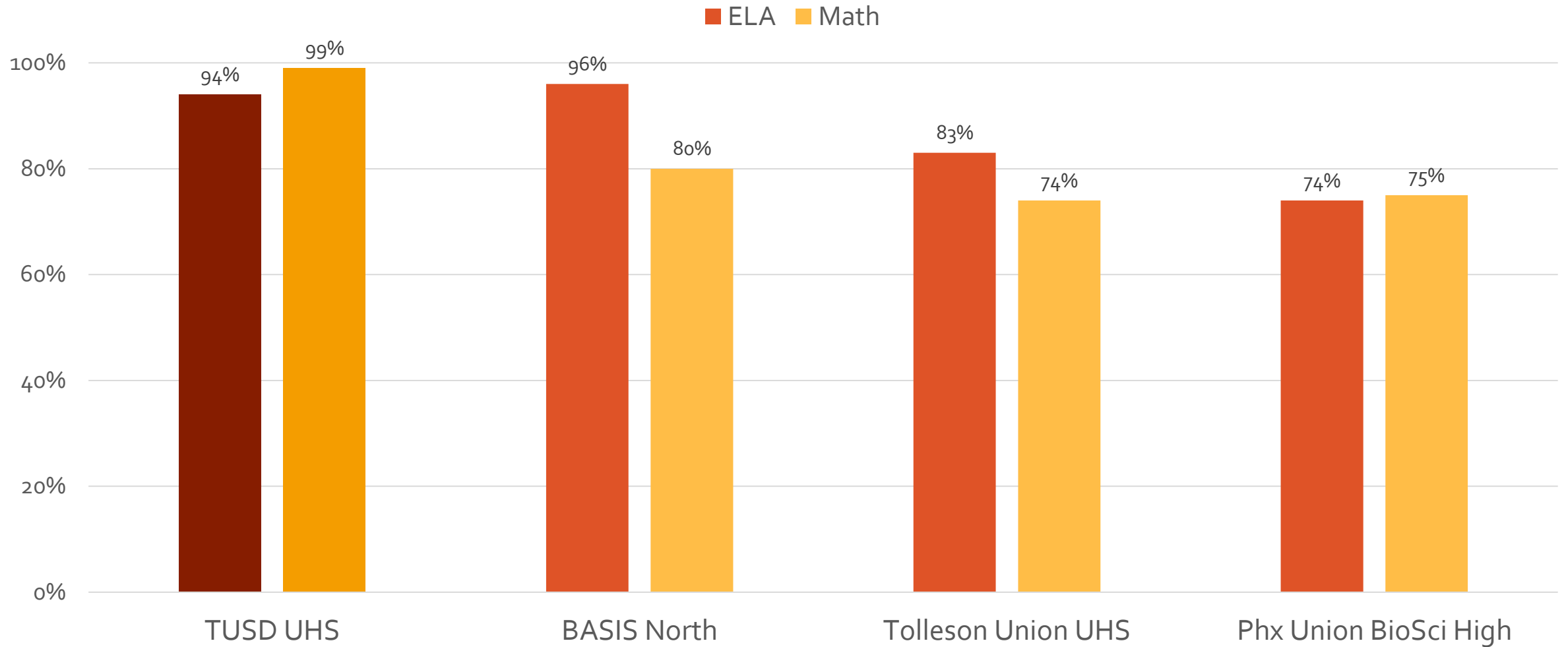
