## **DRESS CODE**

The purpose of the dress code is to help students maintain their personal appearance within the accepted standards of Dodge Traditional Magnet Middle School. Our school colors are black and teal

#### **CHOICES FOR BOTTOM GARMENTS:**

## **Color/Style:**

Solid colored black or khaki beige Dockers or jeans style pants, shorts, or skirts made of cotton blends, denim or corduroy fabrics. All garments must be hemmed. No overalls or ultra baggy pants/shorts allowed. Belts, if worn, must be secured in loops.

#### **Gentlmen:**

Pants and knee length shorts are acceptable. Wallets chains must be kept out of sight, i.e., in the pocket of pants or shorts.

#### **Ladies:**

Shorts, skirts, or capris will be no shorter than the end of your fingers with your hand naturally at your side. Dresses may be worn if they are the correct length, have sleeves, and are of a modest fit and style. Dresses or jumpers must be solid colored in black or tan, or match the dress code top colors (white, baby blue, or dark green) in cotton or cotton twill blends. A jumper can be worn over a dress code shirt. Leggings and fish-net stockings are not allowed. No undergarments should be visible. Accessorizing your outfit must not be a distraction to the learning environment.

#### **CHOICES FOR TOP GARMENTS:**

## **Color/Style:**

Solid white, light blue, and dark green and teal golf style shirt or full button with collar in short or long sleeve. Shirts should be sized appropriate and long enough to remain tucked in while standing and sitting. Shirts should not be form fitting. Undershirts should be white or the color of the outer dress code shirt.

#### Outer Wear:

No professional team apparel or clothing that identifies an affiliation with illegal or racist organizations is allowed. Clothing that advertises sex, profanity, alcohol, tobacco, drugs is not allowed. Outer wear is not to be worn in the classroom during the day unless a student is too cold, then he or she may only wear a solid colored (no large logos) outer wear that remains open

down the front. No pullover sweatshirts may be worn. discouraged in the classroom during the day; students should consider wearing long-sleeved dress code shirt instead. Should a light jacket or sweater be necessary, the body of the jacket must be solid colored (one color, no pattern, stripes etc). Only writing depicting a college or university is allowed. Hoodie style pullovers are not permitted on campus.

#### **Shoes/Sandals:**

The primary color of <u>closed</u> toe shoes should be black, brown, grey or white. No flip-flops, slip-ons, platforms or cleats. Socks are recommended and should not be distracting in appearance. Students are to wear closed toed shoes for safety concerns and the shoes should not be distracting in appearance.

#### Hair:

Hair should not be of extreme contrast to natural hair color and should not be distracting in appearance. No pink, blue, green, red, or unnatural highlights or hair color is allowed.

#### **Jewelry:**

No jewelry in the eyebrow, nose, lip, or tongue is allowed on campus. No gauges or mock gauges are to be worn at school.

#### UNACCEPTABLE CLOTHING

#### **Outerwear:**

Professional sport teams of any kind or sweatshirts with large pattern or design

#### **Shoes/Sandals:**

Thongs, platforms, athletic slides, slip-ons, flip-flops, or shoes with cleats

### Miscellaneous:

See-through garments

Clothing that reveals undergarments

Altered clothing that violates the dress code

Form-fitting garments

Exaggerated or distracting dress

Clothing that identifies or signifies illegal or racist organizations

Clothing that advertises sex, profanity, alcohol, tobacco, drugs

Sunglasses (unless doctor ordered for outside the classroom)

Wallets with chains, chain watches, exaggerated style jewelry (i.e. spiked chokers)

**Tattoos** 

Semi-permanent tattoos or ink markings on skin

#### **Consequences:**

Any student found to be in violation of the dress code will be asked to change. Repeat violations will result in more severe consequences.
