Pursuant to A.R.S. 36-673 (C), TUSD registered nurses may request site-based clinics to administer immunization to school-aged children attending District schools to improve immunization compliance as required by law for school attendance. It has been demonstrated that compliance is enhanced by school site immunizations. School site clinics help prevent suspension for non-compliance as mandated by state law.
