PURPOSE: Present an overview	v of the current status of emergency planning at our schools.		
DESCRIPTION	AND JUSTIFICATION:		
In response to a request from Governing Board Member Michael Hicks, Jeff Coleman, Director of School Safety, Maria Luna, Director of Risk Management and Holly Colonna, Director of Guidance, Counseling/Student Prevention Programs will present an overview of the current status of emergency planning at our schools; School Safety's threat assessment process; plans to apply for Site and Federal Safety funds and the status of our implementation of the Protective Schools Model. This will include a brief history of emergency planning, new state updates to the forms and TUSD personnel's involvement in the process, including our work with ADE and the Pima County Office of Emergency Management. We will present information about ongoing partnerships with law enforcement to provide training to our staff in active shooter/crisis situations and to complete newly mandated emergency drills in tandem with law enforcement at many of our sites. The Governing Board will receive the latest report on physical security of our schools. This data has been used to implement bond funded security upgrades as well as our future plans to use the national model of threat assessment, to include training of staff.			
HOW THIS RELATES TO SUPERINTENDENT'S GOAL(S): The role of School Safety, competent emergency planning and regular drills to provide effective response to emergencies at our schools, directly affects the Superintendents goals of enrollment, customer service and achievement by providing a safe learning environment.
