PURPOSE:

To request Governing Board approval to renew the school-based preventative dental program that provides dental screening, referral, and sealant placement services to TUSD children in 2nd and 6th grade to enhance dental health, at no cost.

DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Tooth decay remains one of the most common childhood chronic diseases. When properly placed, dental sealants are almost 100% effective in preventing tooth decay on the chewing surfaces of the first and second permanent molar teeth.
