- Named African American Studies in 1989
- African American Student Services in 2012
- Focus direct and ancillary support
- Mentoring, tutoring, academic support

# Mexican American Student Services

- Originally Hispanic Studies in 1997
- Changed to Mexican American Studies in 1998
- Name changed to Mexican American Student Services in 2012
- Focus direct and ancillary support
- Mentoring, tutoring, academic support

# <u>Asian Pacific American Student</u> <u>Services</u>

- Pan Asian Studies Department was established in 1998
- Name changed to Asian Pacific American Studies in 2011
- Became Asian Pacific American Student Services in 2012
- Focus direct and ancillary support
- Mentoring, tutoring, classroom support

## Refugee Student Services

- Opened the Refugee Center in 2005
- Moved to Family & Community Outreach in 2010
- Part of Department of Student Equity and Intervention in 2012
- Focus –Acclimate students and families to school and community
- Mentoring, tutoring, classroom support
