PURPOSE:

Extend the agreement for the provision of required childhood immunizations services to the school children of Pima County for a period of one (1) year beginning December 15, 2013 and ending December 14, 2014.

DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Pursuant to A.R.S. 36-673(C), TUSD registered nurses may hold site-based clinics to administer immunizations to school-aged children attending District schools to improve immunization compliance as required by law for school attendance. It has been demonstrated that compliance is enhanced by school site immunizations. School site clinics help prevent suspension for non-compliance as mandated by state law.
