- Email notification sent to 437 potential vendors via <a href="www.azpurchasing.org">www.azpurchasing.org</a>
- Received 12 Statement of Qualifications (SOQ's) from potential general contractors
- Committee, including licensed architect and licensed contractor evaluated SOQ's and ranked them according to their qualifications
- Top five vendors place on the prequalified list for District use

## SELECTION PROCESS

- Drainage work at Tucson High determined by District
  Operations/Projects Department to be done by a General Contractor
- Start with top ranked JOC General Contracting vendor to get estimate for repairs
- Top ranked JOC General Contractor Vendor <u>Kittle Design and</u>
  Construction submitted bid
- District Project Management reviewed Kittle bid and determined it met specifications and is fair and reasonable
- Process in accordance with AZ Administrative Code R7-2-1100 through 1121 Construction Project Delivery Methods
