TITLE:	Study of New Policy IHAMC Requiring Instruction and Training in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation as Required by Senate Bill 1137, Fifty-second Arizona Legislature, Second Regular Session, 2016

#### PURPOSE:

This item presents the Board with the opportunity for first study of an entirely new policy which would require instruction and training in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) no later than July 1, 2019, in accordance with state law.

#### STATEMENT OF POLICY:

This policy incorporates new requirements under state law requiring the provision of training and instruction of students in CPR. This instruction must be in place by July 1, 2019. Adoption of this policy at this time is recommended to ensure action is taken to planning and other action is taken to meet this statutory mandate.

#### **KEY POINTS ABOUT THE POLICY:**

- 1. Requires instruction/training in CPR by no later than July 1, 2019.
- 2. Requires instruction to be based on current evidence-based guidelines.
- 3. Requires age appropriate and hands-on instruction.
- 4. Makes CPR certification optional, but requires properly certified trainers if certification is to be provided.
- 5. Makes provisions for exemption of students where parents object to the training, the student is already CPR certified or trained, or the student's IEP exempts the student.
