Post-Text Reading Level



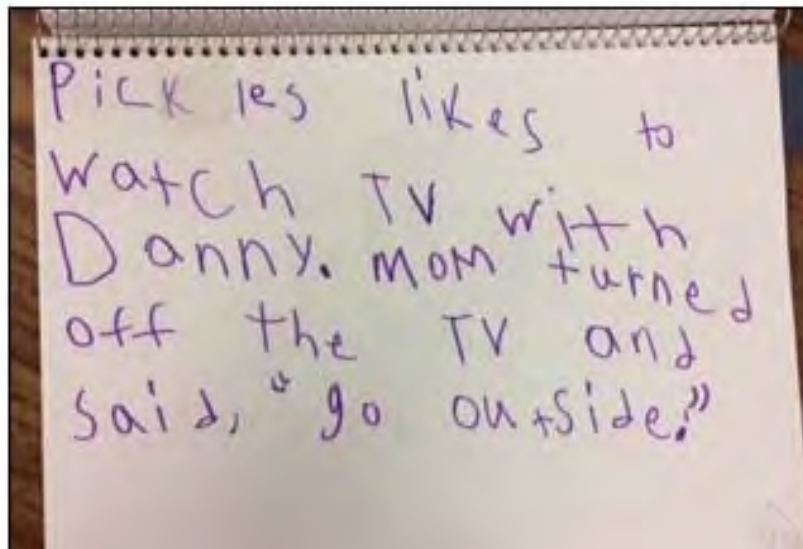
