

Purchase of Wireless Equipment Upgrades using Cooperative Contract



May 23, 2017

Background Information



- During an AAR of AzMERIT testing completed in May, the District identified 11 schools in need of wireless upgrades.
- These sites did not receive new wireless hardware during the District's IT Infrastructure Modernization Initiative (ITIMI) as their existing hardware was considered up-to-date at the time.
- Advances in technology have since caused the hardware at these sites to become outdated.

Sites Affected and Cost

- \$440K has been allocated to complete the wireless upgrades at all 11 sites, including \$134K in USP funding to help ensure that equal access to the Internet is provided district-wide.

Contract Information



- The District recently conducted RFP 18-02-20 for Technology Products and Services and awarded the contract to CDW-G Corporation, effective July 1, 2017.
- To purchase the equipment from CDW-G at the same rate prior to June 30, 2017, the District must utilize Arizona State Master Contract ADSPO16-137341 .
- Since this purchase exceeds \$250K, Governing Board approval is required.
