

**AMENDMENT 1 TO INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE CITY OF TUCSON AND TUCSON UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT
FOR THE DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION AND JOINT USE OF LIGHTING FACILITIES
AT
TOWNSEND MIDDLE SCHOOL**

This First Amendment to Intergovernmental Agreement (“Amendment”) is entered into among Tucson Unified School District of Pima County, a political subdivision of the State of Arizona (“TUSD”), The City of Tucson, a political subdivision of the State of Arizona, on behalf of the City of Tucson Parks and Recreation Department (“CITY”) and Ft. Lowell Soccer Club, a non-profit organization (“FT. LOWELL SOCCER CLUB”).

RECITALS

1. On January 8, 2001 and by City Resolution No. 18821, TUSD and CITY entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement (“IGA”) dated as of January 8, 2001, and recorded on January 17, 2001, in Book 11466, pages 1237 through 1249, in the official records of Pima County, Arizona, to permit the public use of certain outdoor recreational facilities (“Soccer Fields”) at Townsend Middle School (“Townsend”) when those facilities are not in use by the school. Attachment “D” to the IGA is a Financial Participation/Use Agreement (“FPUS”) between the CITY and FT. LOWELL SOCCER CLUB.
2. On September 15, 2015, TUSD entered into an agreement to sell the property to Pima Medical Institute.
3. TUSD owns a school facility known as the Booth-Fickett Math / Science Magnet School (“Booth-Fickett”), a portion of the fields of which are illustrated on Attachment A which is attached to this Amendment and incorporated by reference herein.
4. TUSD, CITY and FT. LOWELL SOCCER CLUB have determined that it is in all parties’ best interest to amend the IGA and the FPUA to allow the Soccer Fields and Field Lights to be relocated to Booth-Fickett.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE PARTIES HEREY AMEND THE IGA AND THE
FPUA AS FOLLOWS:**

1. All references to Townsend in the IGA and the FPUA shall be replaced by Booth-Fickett.
2. TUSD shall coordinate with the CITY and FT. LOWELL SOCCER CLUB to prepare the Booth-Fickett fields and install lighting and other equipment as shown on Exhibit A attached hereto to replace the Soccer Fields at Townsend.
