The purpose of this program is to increase high school student interest in life science and to increase the number of students matriculating to university/college/community college STEM programs. The program provides advanced biology coursework and laboratory techniques. High school students pay the agreed upon tuition and fees, successfully pass the class, and then receive University credit.
