STATEMENT OF POLICY:

An agreement to resolve state complaint was entered on May 23, 2016 that requests the District Administration shall recommend to the Governing Board that Governing Board Policy IHBf - Homebound Instruction be revised to include the following statement: "Nothing in this Policy is intended to limit the District's obligation to provide a free appropriate public education to students with disabilities who qualify under protections of Section 504 or the Individuals with Disabilities Act and may require home instruction, services, supports or accommodations for disability related or medical reasons".
