



TUSD Proficiency Rates on AzMERIT ELA Compared to the State 2017 ■TUSD 16-17 ■ State








TUSD Proficiency Rates on AzMERIT MATH Compared to the State 2017 TUSD16-17 State




















CONCLUSIONS FROM 3 YEARS OF AZMERIT DATA

- SCORES ARE SLOWLY IMPROVING OVER TIME
- ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS HAVE SHOWN THE GREATEST IMPROVEMENT IN BOTH ELA AND MATH
- 5TH GRADE HAS SHOWN THE LARGEST PROFICIENCY INCREASE OF ANY GRADE
- WHEN COMPARED TO STATE PROFICIENCY, MIDDLE SCHOOLS SHOW THE BIGGEST GAP IN BOTH ELA AND MATH
- THE ACHIEVEMENT GAP BETWEEN ETHNICITIES HAS REMAINED CONSISTENT OVER THE LAST 3
 YEARS
- MATH HAS SHOWN GREATER PROFICIENCY INCREASES OVERALL THAN ELA
- ALE PROGRAMS HAS REMAINED CONSISTENT IN PROFICIENCY
