PURPOSE:

To request Governing Board approval of the Comprehensive Magnet Plan for the 2015-2016 school year as presented.

DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

The Unitary Status Plan and Court Order 1753 require that the District work in collaboration with the Special Master to develop and implement a Comprehensive Magnet Plan that includes Magnet School Plans for each site. This plan addresses continuous school improvement strategies and magnet school recruitment, retention, and marketing.

At the June 9th Board Meeting the Board approved the preliminary 2015-16 Comprehensive Magnet Plan. We are presenting the Revised Comprehensive Magnet Plan that was submitted to the courts on July 7, 2015.
