BULLYING IS A NATIONAL ISSUE AFFECTING SCHOOL DISTRICTS

- One out of every four students (22%) report being bullied during the school year. (<u>National Center for Educational</u> <u>Statistics, 2015</u>)
- More than half of bullying situations (57 percent) stop when a peer intervenes on behalf of the student being bullied. (<u>Hawkins, Pepler, and Craig, 2001</u>)
- School-based bullying prevention programs decrease bullying by up to 25%. (<u>McCallion and Feder, 2013</u>)
- 19.6% of high school students in the US report being bullied at school in the past year. 14.8% reported being bullied online. (Center for Disease Control, 2014)


