	POLICY CODE: EI

The Board has the responsibility to maintain an adequate property, casualty, and liability insurance program to protect District property; to protect the Board members and employees against general liability resulting from the discharge of their duties; and to offer protection in case of injury for employees while acting in behalf of the school. The Board may also authorize a voluntary insurance program for students and employees.

The responsibility of administering the total insurance program shall be delegated to the Risk Management Department under the direction of the Superintendent. The Risk Management Department will seek and consider input from the insurance broker, who has been chosen through competitive bid. The District will make every effort to obtain insurance at the most economical cost, consistent with required service. The insurance will be placed in sound companies, except in those cases where judgment dictates that the District bears its own risk.
