PURPOSE:

To adopt Policy IHBA as previously studied at the July 24, 2012 Governing Board Meeting.

DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

It is the responsibility of the District to identify and evaluate students who, within the intent of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, need special services or programs in order that such students may receive the required free and appropriate education.

The policy was last revised in 1995. It needs revision to better reflect language contained in Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973. The proposed policy is based on ASBA Model Policy.

Policy has been reviewed by the Policy Subcommittee, Legal Department and posted on the Governing Board Website.
