


#### Survey Methodology

- Surveys were taken by Town Hall participants at Sahuaro, Cholla and Catalina High Schools as well as on-line on the TUSD web site
- Instrument was handed out when participants arrived at the various Town Halls and they were encouraged to fill them out after hearing the presentations made by TUSD staff (web surveys were filled out at the leisure of the respondents)
- The survey instrument was offered in English and Spanish for both the Town Hall hard copy versions and the web-based survey




#### Guiding Principles – Combined Results






#### Guiding Principles – Sahuaro Town Hall






#### Guiding Principles – Cholla Town Hall






#### Guiding Principles – Catalina Town Hall










#### Budget Options – Sahuaro Town Hall






#### Budget Options – Cholla Town Hall






#### Budget Options – Catalina Town Hall





## Budget Options – Top Choice Comparisons (Venue)






#### Other options to be considered

- Partnerships with local entities
  - Businesses to sponsor schools
  - Utilizing resources of UA/PCC for programs
  - Renting out TUSD resources to other entities


Are each of the options presented clear and understandable?





#### **Understand Associated Costs/Revenues**


Do you fully understand the costs and/or revenues associated with each of the options presented?
