During the 2013-2014 School Year, EEF →

- Awarded 46 classroom grants to educator initiated projects, that will benefit students at 25 schools
- Awarded college scholarships to 23 high school seniors
- Awarded \$over \$7,000 in cash awards to teachers and students
- Provided 903 sports and fine arts participation fees to 722 high school students
- Including fees for 4 of the Tucson High state soccer championship team players and 3 of the Palo Verde baseball team players
- Provided free eye exams and eyeglasses to 211 children
- Provided 891 students the ability to shop for shoes in a retail store
- Provided over \$26,000 in clothes and shoes to the TUSD Clothing Bank
- Provided over \$24,000 in school supplies to 23 Title 1 Schools
- Provided almost \$18,000 in assistance to Tucson High School students for state or national level competitions
- Provided over \$2,600 in snacks to tutoring programs
