## **PURPOSE:**

To consider the possibility of treating Title I funds, or grant fund generally, separately for the purpose of administrative and instructional spending targets.

Grants funds are frequently subject to different constraints and decision-making processes than the general funding streams.

Direction to principals concerning the allocation of schools' Title I funds, in the service of the overall spending targets, has adversely eroded site autonomy in the use of these funds.
