PURPOSE:

Provide the Board with information about an Advanced Learning Experiences (ALE) Open-Access GATE program in Roberts-Naylor.

DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

In August, beginning with the sixth grade, the District initiated a middle-school, Open-Access GATE program at Roberts-Naylor. This program serves the Roberts-Naylor students, offers a pipeline for the Tully Open-Access GATE students, and provides openenrollment opportunities to other students. In a central location, it will increase student access to ALE through GATE endorsed teachers using GATE pedagogy and instructional strategies.
