

For the School year 2015-2016:

- We helped 873 high school students participated in extracurricular activities, including team sports and fine arts
- 97% of those seniors whose activity fees were paid graduated, and over 85% are enrolled in college upon high school graduation
- 240 students received free eye examinations and eyeglasses
- 850 students received new shoes and socks at our Shoe Shopping "parties" at Payless Shoe Source
- 51 Classroom Grants were awarded to TUSD teachers for innovative programs
- 31 high school seniors were awarded EEF college scholarships
- EEF collected over \$5,000 in school supplies at our Walmart Stuff-the-Bus event
- EEF brokered volunteers from Citi to start coming to the TUSD Clothing Bank once a month
- EEF delivered over \$10,000 in collected school supplies to Booth Fickett
- EEF attended community events, like the Food Bank Walk for Hunger, to remind people of the need in TUSD
- EEF was awarded \$148,500 by Angel Charity to fund high school sports and fine arts fees, and to bring the program into middle schools in August 2017
- EEF stocked the TUSD Clothing Bank with backpacks, uniforms and shoes
- EEF distributed thousands of school supplies items to TUSD students
