PURPOSE:

STATEMENT OF POLICY:

Clarifies Governing Board authority with respect to individual Board requests for information, reports and the like.

KEY POINTS ABOUT THE POLICY:

Policy BBAA incorporates basic legal tenets and rules regarding the authority of the Governing Board members as both individuals and when acting as members of the body.

REPLACES WHAT POLICY:

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The new language simply expands on existing language to make clear the fact that where an individual Governing Board Member request for information or other action would require the use of District resources, then Governing Board action (through the entire governing body) is required to authorize the same.
