PURPOSE:

To study revisions to policy JLCD.

DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Under certain circumstances, when it is necessary for a student to take medicine during school hours, the District health service providers will arrange for the administration of such medicine if certain requirements are met.

The policy is being updated to reflect requirements when medicines need to be taken on field trips, as requested by Health Services.
