

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPEAL OF COURT ORDER  
AND CONTINUED COMPLIANCE DURING APPEAL PERIOD**

WHEREAS, Tucson Unified School District remains committed to the principles of diversity, integration and equity whether or not the Fisher and Mendoza cases remain pending; and

WHEREAS, Tucson Unified School District asserts that the legal standards for termination of court supervision in the Fisher and Mendoza cases have been met, and that the District has complied in good faith with court orders in these cases;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved as follows:

1. Counsel for the District is authorized and instructed to seek appellate review of the Court's most recent order in the Fisher and Mendoza cases (ECF 2123).
2. District staff is instructed to fully comply with that order pending appeal unless a stay or modification of the order is granted.
