PURPOSE:

To consider instructing the Governing Board's legal representatives on its response and/or action based on the Order issued by the Federal District Court on 9/6/18.

DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

On September 6, 2018, the Federal District Court issued a lengthy order in the Fisher et als v. Tucson Unified School District. In the order, the Court granted unitary status to TUSD, in Part, and also denied it in other respects. In the process, the Court detailed a number of actions required of the District before the Court will consider granting full unitary status.

The Governing Board has received legal advice in duly-convened executive sessions, and, individually, the opportunity to ask questions of its counsel in an otherwise privileged environment regarding the order. At this point, the Governing Board will have the opportunity to provide direction to its attorneys regarding next steps in pleadings or other response to the Court's order.
