ARTICLE THIRTY

SALARY 30-1 Salaries

- A. The salary schedule AS SPECIFIED IN ARTICLE 30-9 for the duration of the agreement shall be effective July 1, 2014. UNTIL THE TUSD GOVERING BOARD VOTES TO CHANGE AT AN OPEN TUSD GOVERNING BOARD MEETING. as specified in Article 30-9 and 30-10.
- B. THE SALARY SCHEDULE SHALL INCLUDE A YEARLY EXPERIENCE INDEX INCREASE PROPORTIONAL TO THE EXPERIENCE CREDIT THAT A NEW HIRE TO THE DISTRIC RECIEVES FOR A YEAR OF EXPERIENCE. AT THE COMPLETION OF EACH YEAR OF DISTRICT SERVICE TEACHERS WILL ADVANCE ONE STEP ON THE SALARY SCHEDULE PENDING GOVERNING BOARD APPROVAL.
- C. B. The salary schedule will not reflect compensation attained through advanced degrees, professional development, or district service stipend.
- D. C. TUSD shall continue the practice of discussing special compensation issues with the Association. An example includes incentives for MBUs at those schools under improvement due to state or federal labels.
