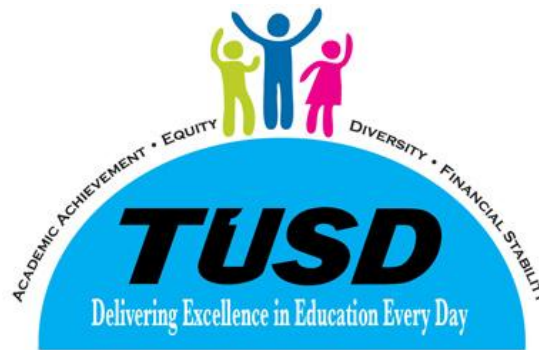

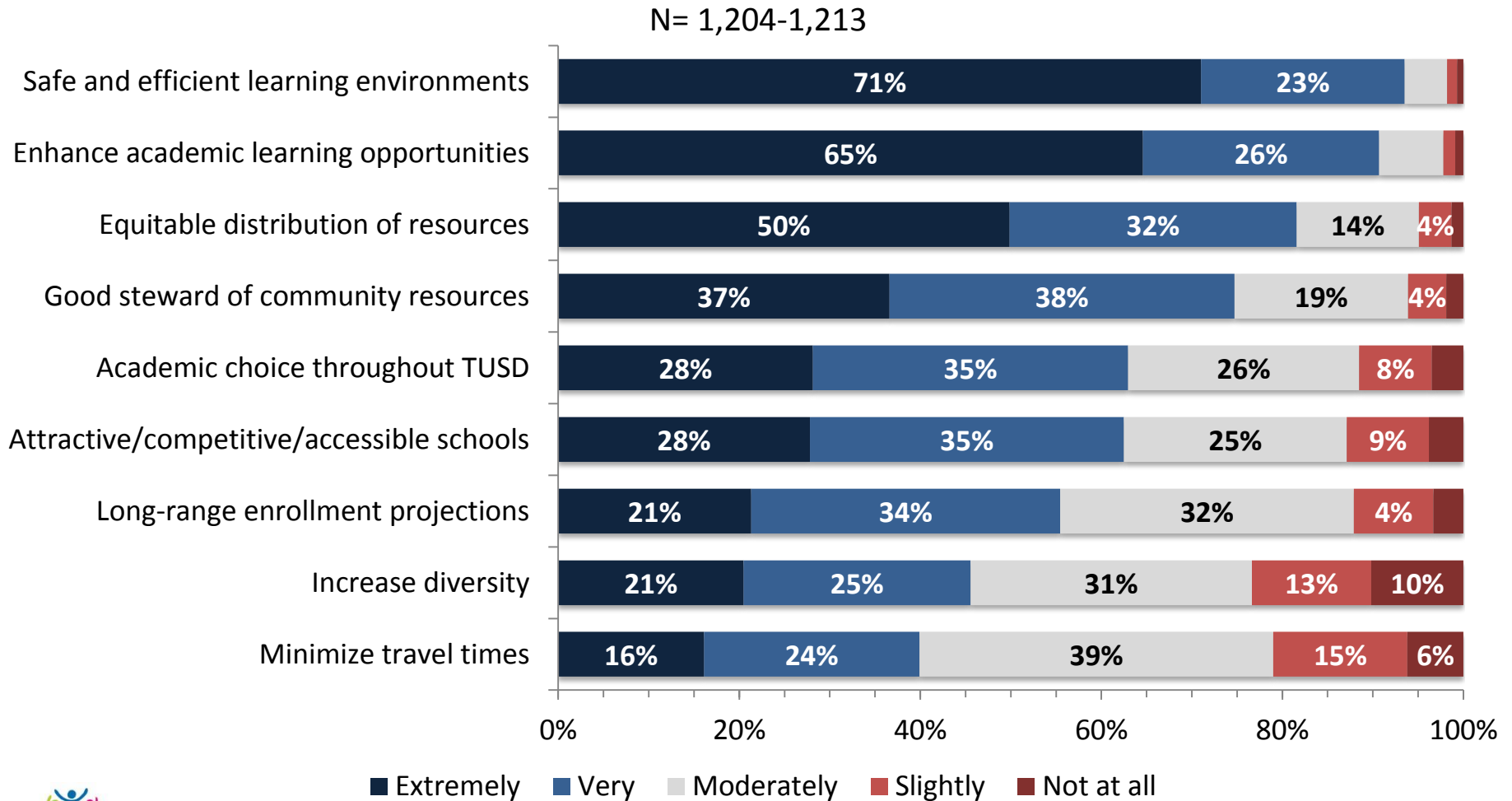

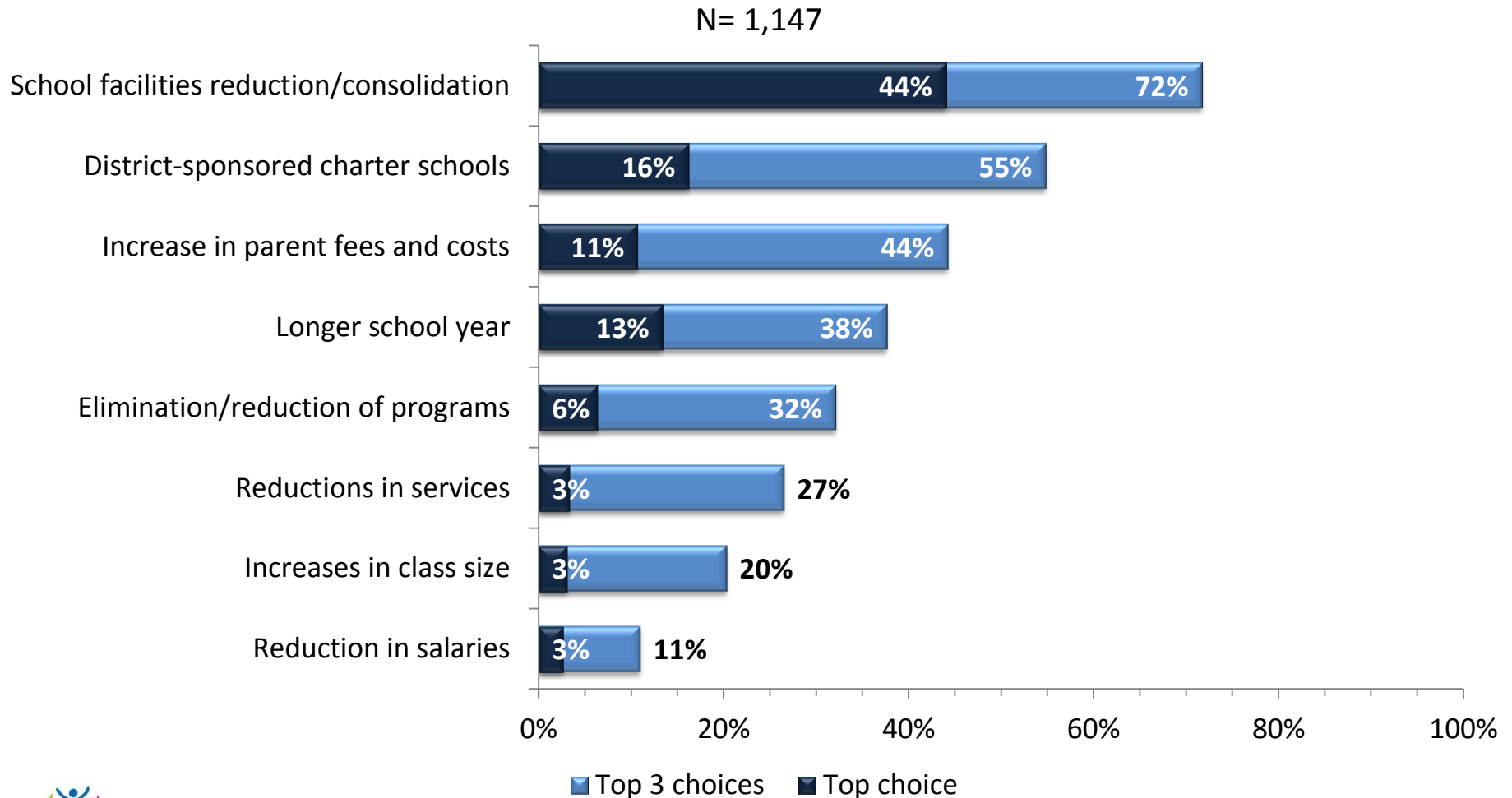
Guiding Principles – Combined Results

 How important are each of these principles to the district and community as a whole:

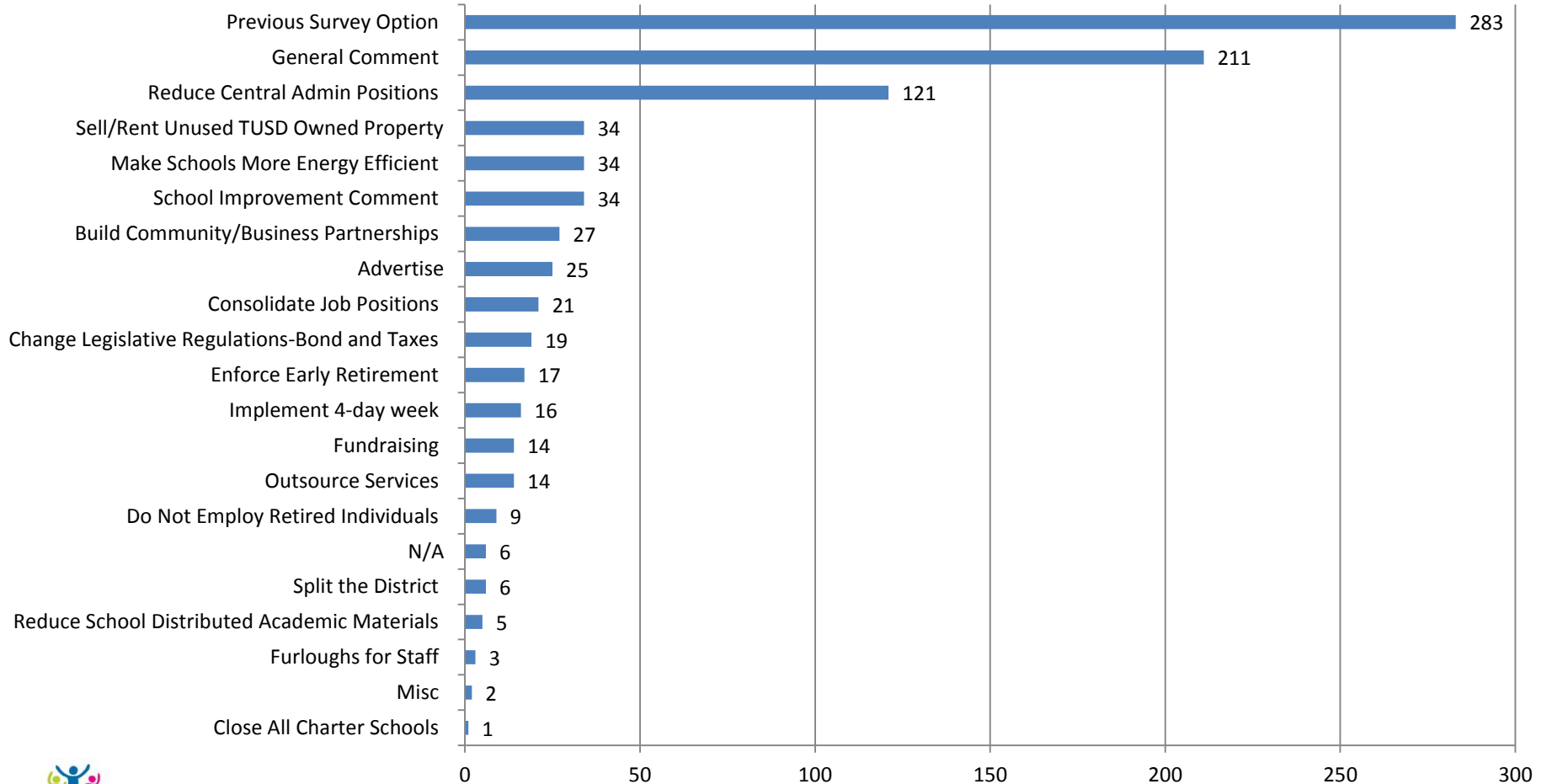


Budget Options – Combined Results

Choose the top three options (one per choice) to balance TUSD's budget without sacrificing academic achievement, with 1 being your top choice:



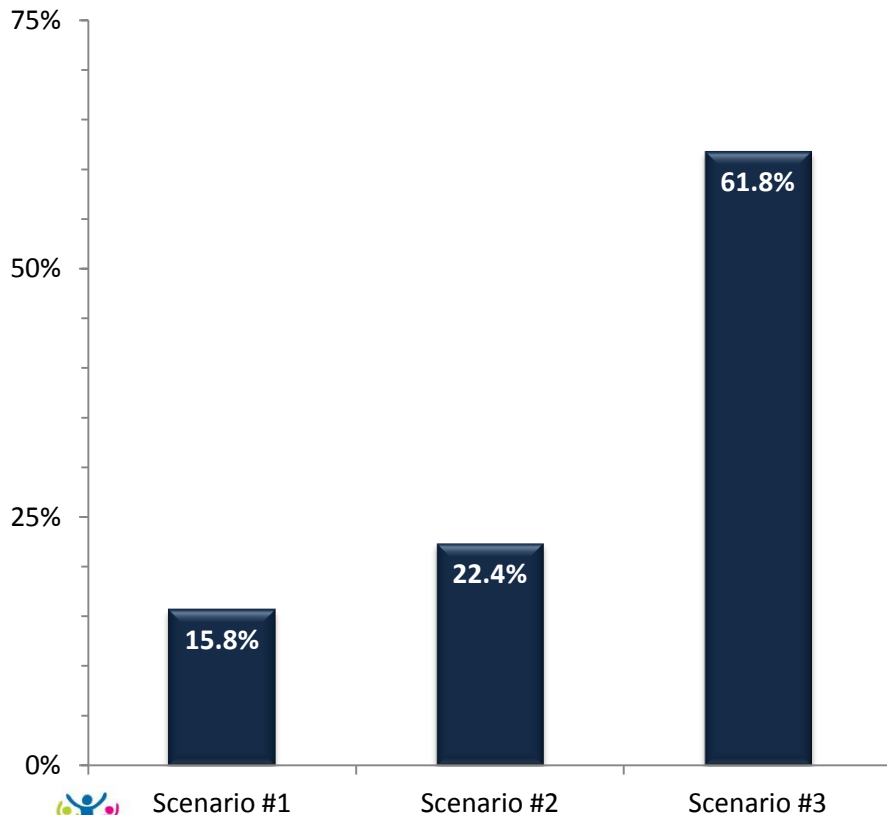

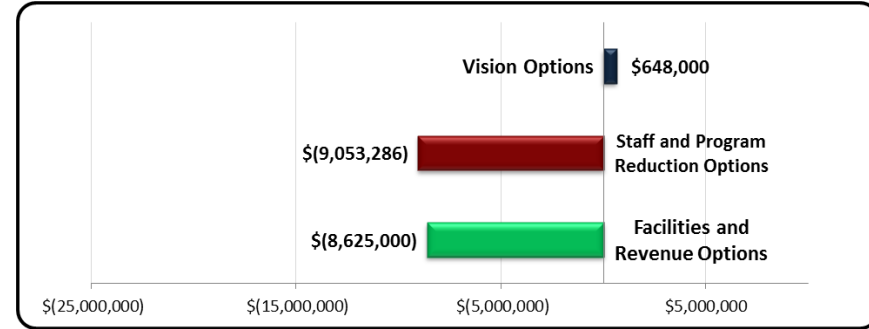
Scenario preference based on a \$17 million deficit

Which of the three scenarios do you support the most?

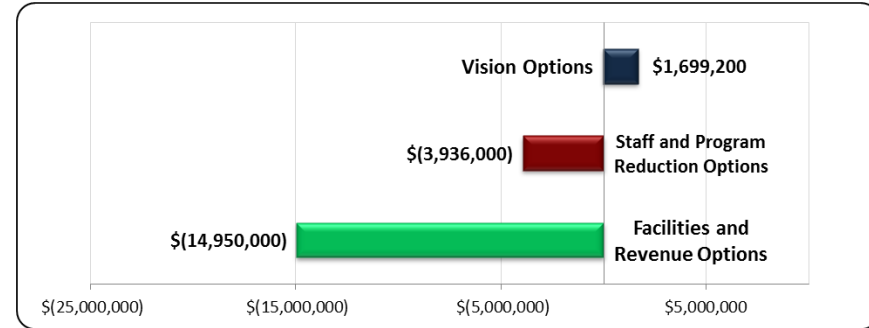
\$17 million deficit scenarios - Most preferred (n= 558)



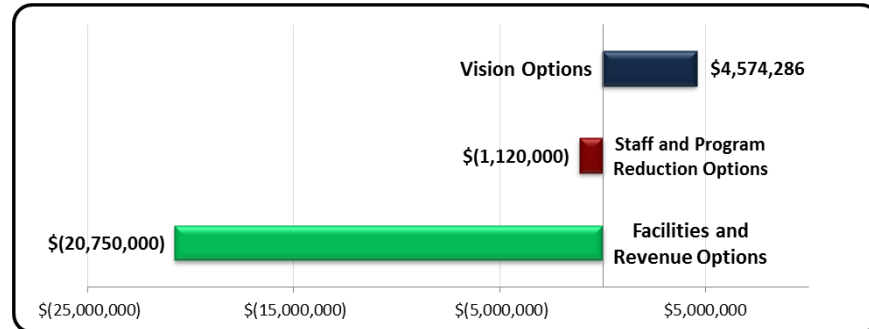

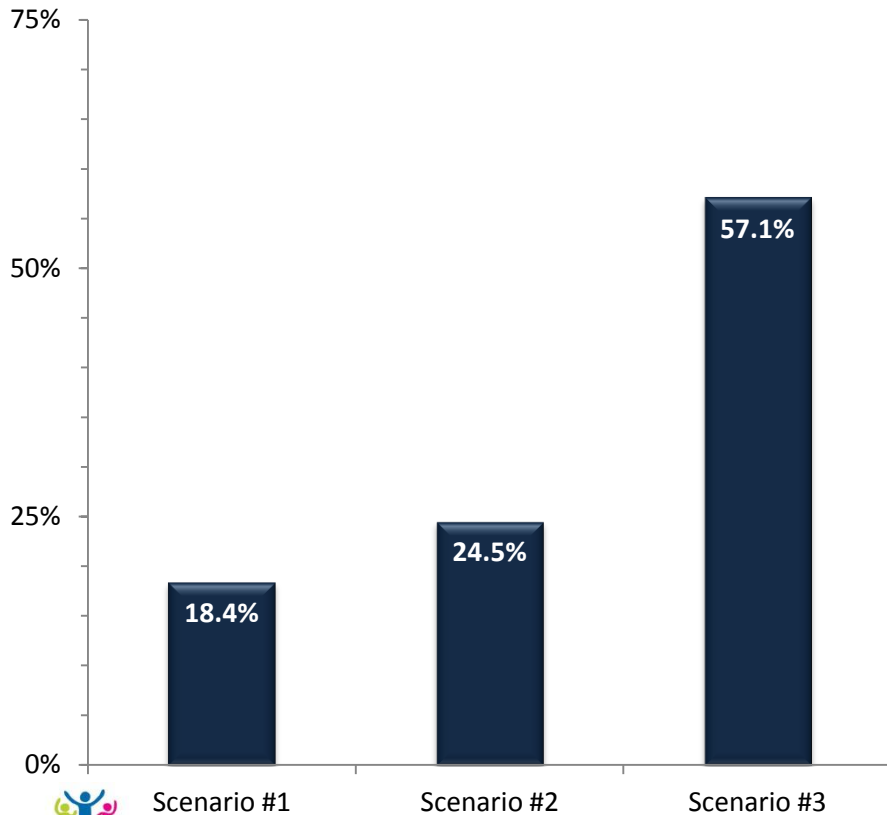

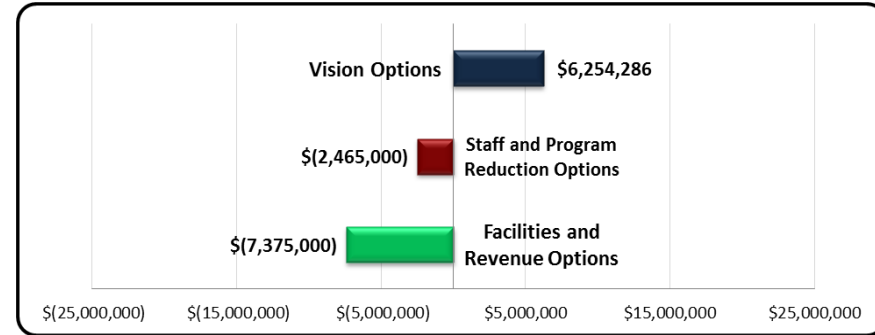
Scenario preference based on the passage of Proposition 204

Which of the three scenarios do you support the most?

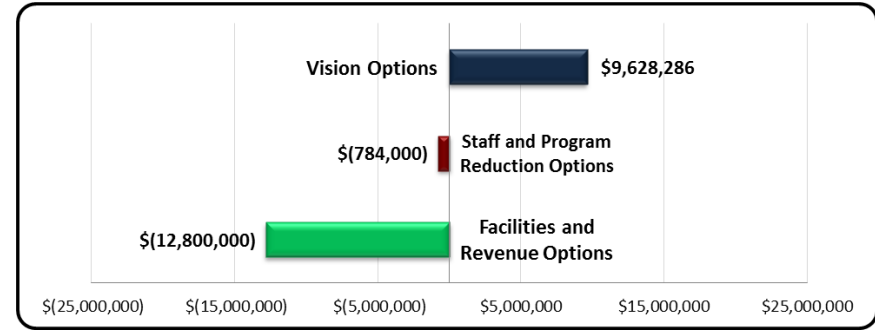
Prop 204 passage scenarios - Most preferred (n = 494)



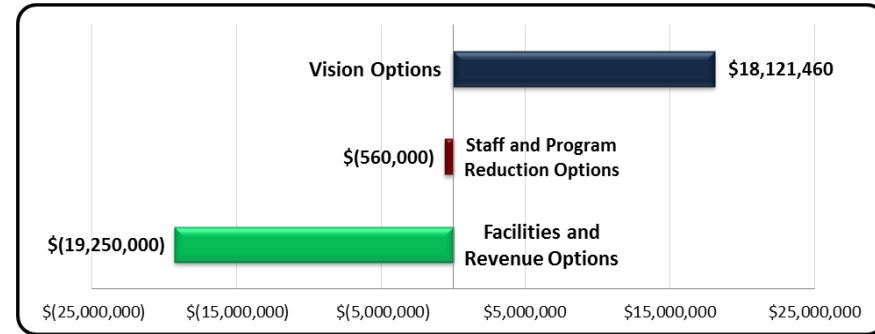
