This policy covers three areas of staff conduct. The first, covers the expectations of how an employee will conduct themselves along with potential consequences for violating the rules. The second part covers reporting suspected crimes or incidents. The third covers the use of physical force by supervisory personnel.				
All three elements of this policy are current TUSD policies. We are recommending the individual policies be eliminated and replaced with this one policy.				
This is the ASBA Model with a few wording changes to the third part, concerning physical force. The changes are illustrated in the strike through version as contributed by Kristel Foster.
