PURPOSE:

To adopt revisions to Policy JLCD as previously studied at the October 2, 2012 Governing Board meeting.

DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

Under certain circumstances, when it is necessary for a student to take medicine during school hours, the District Health Service Providers will arrange for the administration of such medicine, if certain requirements are met.

As requested by Health Services, the policy is being revised to reflect requirements to follow when medicines need to be taken on field trips.

The policy has been reviewed by the Policy Subcommittee, the Legal Department, Health Services and posted on the Governing Board website.

Members of the Policy Subcommittee and the Director of Health Services, Donna Johnson, will be available to answer questions.
