

2019-2022 Calendar Survey Comments

#1 concern--TUSD breaks should match UA spring breaks, otherwise, better to have no spring break. Should also respect Jewish holidays such as Rosh Hashanna, Yom Kippur, and Passover.

2 changes I would like would be add a Wednesday for Thanksgiving break and take one day off at Christmas break. Also have a few days before Christmas off instead of a few days off after New Years. It would help with travel and/or planning for the holidays. Having Christmas break right before Christmas Eve is too hard.

2 days off for fall break. Then take full week off of thanksgiving.

3 days off got Fall & Spring Breaks? WHY????????? That's ridiculous. Maybe you guys should go in the classrooms and teach while those overworked hardworking teachers get the TRUE Breaks they deserve.

A better calendar would be to do away with Rodeo Days altogether. Give a Friday and Monday, or Thursday and Friday for Fall Break. Put Spring Break right after Easter & do away with Spring Holiday. Or give the Monday after Easter, or Friday & Monday of Easter weekend off. #RedforEdisDEAD

A calendar with an option of the Wednesday before Thanksgiving off would be preferable; i.e., Wednesday - Friday off for Thanksgiving. Thanksgiving is a major holiday, and it's difficult to travel, plan, etc. with school held on that Wednesday.

A change in vacation break dates would be extremely disruptive to legal parenting time plans that are in place.

A full week break for fall & spring is good for staff and students to relax and come back prepared to resume learning

A full week for fall and spring break are best. Some districts have a 3 week Fall break which is too much, however 3 days is too little.

A full week of fall break is crucial for RUHS band as well as other fine arts programs to maintain their outstanding levels of performance and high reputation in Arizona.

A is a much better choice!

A is the best for all school years.

A longer summer vacation is not positive for the children's retention of skills from one year to the next.

Additionally, it adds a great fiscal burden to the summer that we are able to negate spread over the year.

A lot of these calendars and surveys do not include the pre-K/transition/special education students. It would be nice to have more focused messages for those groups whose schedules differ from the typical classes.

A week for fall and spring break is a hardship for Working parents. I pay over 300 for a week of childcare for two kids. It's not doable.

A week long break for both fall and spring break is important so teachers don't get burnt out.

A week long Fall break allows for sports and band to schedule practice or rehearsal as they get close to their championship or state competitions while still allowing for families to have time off.

Add an option for a 1 week Thanksgiving Break with shorter fall break.

Adjusting the calendar to start on a Monday for all options would be better

Aligning the school calendars with other large school districts in the Tucson area is ideal.

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All of these make no sense other than you get 1 extra day off for Easter.. It should go back to how it was when I was in school, we started on Aug 18th and ended on May 19th.. with all of the same breaks.. I dont like the kids Starting so early in August...

All of these options seem fine to me *provided that affordable childcare options continue to be available during breaks*. It would also be great if TUSD's spring break could line up with UA's.

All options have too many days off. All breaks should only be a Friday Mon Tues off. Kids lose too much knowledge with long breaks.

Allowing a full calendar week for fall and spring break makes it easier to plan cover at work and to plan vacations. The partial weeks feel awkward.

Although I do not have a student in the school district, Option "A" matches up with their school districts preposed calendar with matching fall and spring breaks.

Although I have no children in kinder I think starting on a Monday makes for a long week for young children. My kids are older as would be able to handle it but I think starting on Thursday has been the best thing tusd has done. It gives everyone a gradual start to the school year.

Amphi has a good schedule. No grading day. Conferences held 3 days before fall break and report cards handed out then. I would rather start Monday, August 5, skip grading days, and have full week for fall and spring break.

An Aug 1 start makes it impossible for students to finish internships and extracurricular activities abroad or in other states.

An August 1 start makes it very difficult for students to participate in any activities, camps, or internships in any state outside of Arizona. We want our students to be competitive in national college admissions and should not deprive them of these opportunities that exist for students everywhere else. Please balance this with the need for breaks throughout the year.

As a classified support staff I really like the full week off for fall break but its is such a financial hardship to not get paid for that full week. I feel like I am just getting back on my feet from not being paid during the summer and then a full week unpaid and an unpaid grading day is very hard on my family. I vote for less unpaid days off

As a family, we have our vacation times planned out around the way the schedule is now. It's great the way it is.

As a parent and as a stay-at-home mother, I can tell you that my children need and enjoy a full week off during fall break.

As a parent and teacher, I feel strongly that students need a full fall and spring break. Students begin to get sick--emotionally and physically--once the weather changes and the stress and exhaustion of first quarter has set in. With a week off for fall break, students rest and regroup. I have taught at UHS for 18 years and I have 3 kids in TUSD k-6th and I have noticed a significant improvement in student work and health as well as teachers and staff once we started a week of fall break. Teachers use fewer subs, kids miss fewer days. The amount of time kids miss for illness would exceed the amount of time we give for the full week breaks. I believe taking the full fall and spring breaks actually cuts down on the absences from illness and stress for both TUSD faculty, staff and students. The improvement in the health of the whole community is far more important than starting later. I know it can be a hardship for working parents, but in my observation and experience, the benefits for the week long breaks surpass those challenges.

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As a teacher support, I see the need for a fall break week that allows teachers to come back rejuvenated for the challenging second semester which can be challenging for students with holiday stressors.

As a teacher trained in child psychology and pedagogy with the best interests of my students and fellow teachers at heart, I would highly recommend staying on the current schedule of 1-week fall and spring breaks.

As a teacher, I find a full week of Fall Break and Spring Break very important. It gives me time to do a better job of planning for the upcoming quarter. I use my Fall and Spring breaks not only to rejuvenate, but also review and reflect on the past quarter and to use that information to prepare. If it is less than a week, I would still spend my time reviewing/reflecting/planning/preparing, but I would not have much time for resting and rejuvenating.

As a teacher, the week long break during fall and spring really helps.

As a teacher, with all the additional trainings and meetings, etc., now required by TUSD, those full-week holidays in fall and spring are extremely important both for stress reduction, but also for grading and prep -- time for which has been reduced during the active school days.

As an educator and parent, I really appreciate starting the year off on a Thursday for students. I don't want that to change. As well I want the full week off for fall and spring breaks.

As an employee I like the school calendar as is and do not want it to change.

As part of the TUSD staff, it is essential for staff to have breaks during the school year. These breaks provide staff time for well deserved self-care, everything from going on vacation to just taking care of necessary medical appointments, car services, and family needs.

Aside from this, I would opt for a schedule that has school starting later in the summer - I don't understand why it starts so early now...

B is the worst choice, we need Spring Break

This also helps with the family budget when it comes to hiring out for baby sitters.

Because Fall and Spring breaks are unpaid for less than twelve month employees, they pose extreme financial hardship for me and my family. I would prefer that they be as brief as possible, but will respect the wishes of everyone involved and continue to feel extremely lucky to be part of the Tucson Unified School District.

For families with two working parents, random days off such as the proposed 3 day fall break are a big strain. I'd rather have no such break and start school a week later than what amounts to a 5 day weekend. (also, few alternative care programs run in those tiny breaks, placing even greater burden on families.) Also, May 20 feels like a very early end date. Is it really essential to end before Memorial Day?

For question #3, my child is currently in a preschool program at one of the elementary schools, so I marked K-5 since there was no other option for the pre-k students.

Full week breaks during fall and spring has been nice and has given youth a chance to take a breather and motivates them to continue to work hard.

I believe it is crucial to keep Fall Breaks, Winter Breaks, and Spring Breaks in full week configurations; to start some on Thursdays and Fridays through Mondays is an invitation for wide-spread absences before and after the breaks.

I believe it is important for both students and teachers to have a full week break between 1st and second quarter (Fall break) and between 3rd and 4th quarter (Spring Break) in order to recuperate and be able to better transition back into a school schedule refreshed and ready to tackle more content with an open mind and enthusiastic spirit.

It is always a high absence day; just start school one day earlier and stop fighting the mass exodus the day before Thanksgiving.

School calendar option B splits Spring break between weeks so that I will have to return to court and change this order. This will cost me about \$2,000 (or more if he fights it). I am STRONGLY OPPOSED to Option B.

I have a strong preference for start date that's closer to the 2nd week of August.
