• 17-18

- No district-level organization in the past. Now, site coordinator (Tammy) overseeing Edgenuity at the district level, ensuring consistency and leadership.
- No accountability at each site, now we have a site coordinator at each site.
- No policy manual last year, we now have one in place and it is being revised to include lessons learned.
- 16-17 there were 11 PD sessions delivered. In 17-18, there have been 21 sessions delivered. We have 1 webinar and 10 PD days remaining. PD planning for 18-19 is key.
- We are now delivering coaching instead of just whole group.
- We were only doing CR in the high school. Now we have Blended Learning at Project Moore and all district middle schools have been trained on MyPath.
- Agave has been broken out to its own district, making for a smoother experience.






Concurrent Usage – Similar Arizona School Districts

- Usage increased year-over-year from 2014-15 through 2017-18.
- Students demonstrated content mastery, earning an average overall grade of 73% in 14-15, 69% in 15-16, and 77% in 16-17.
- Overall, students demonstrated significant gains on pretest to posttest lesson quizzes (41 point increase in 14-15, 35 point increase in 15-16, and 32 point increase in 16-17).
- 75% students completed their courses in 14-15, 57% in 15-16, and 86% in 16-17.
- Students who spend more time in courses completed more course activities.

- Establishing consistent policies and procedures.
- Defining success metrics at district and school levels.
- Establishing buy-in and setting clear roles, responsibilities, and expectations for schools, teachers, and counselors in the virtual program.
- Securing a site coordinator to ensure consistent and unified communications.
- Managing training for Edgenuity programs across the district.
- Scheduling sessions/visits for continuous improvement.

Recommendations

- Broadcast fidelity expectations.
- Increase online engagement and motivation.
- Encourage students to use courses more often.
- Closely monitor student performance data to optimize comprehension of subject material and course completion.
