History of Bonillas

- Opened in 1953
- Named after Ignacio Bonillas
- Opened as Bonillas Basic Curriculum Magnet School for the 1983-1984 school year
- Was designed to attract students who work best in a structured environment



Bonillas LEADS

- Learning—advanced hands on learning experiences in all academic subject areas
- Exploring—an educational environment in which all students will investigate careers
- Achieving—a rigorous curriculum in which ALL students are challenged and supported
- Discovering Diversity—differences are valued
- Serving— use of real world problem solving and high order thinking skills for the global 21st century and their own community

Achievements

- 67% Integration in Kindergarten in 2016-2017 and 73% Schoolwide
- Received a special recognition award in 2015-2106 for increase in enrollment
- 95% Attendance Rate in 2015-2016 "Met" by ADE
- 55% of our students were approaching to highly proficient in ELA AZMerit in 2015-2016 as compared to 50% of the district
- 72% of our students were approaching to highly proficient in Math AZMerit in 2015-2016 as compared to 52% of the district
- Fuel Up to Play 60 Touchdown School in 2016!
