There shall be no hazing, solicitation to engage in hazing, or aiding and abetting another who is engaged in hazing of any person enrolled, accepted for, or promoted to District schools within twelve (12) calendar months.						
This policy is the ASBA Model which includes the requirement to use the statutory definition of hazing along with reporting procedures.						
This policy has been reviewed by the Policy Subcommittee, the Legal Department and posted on the Governing Board website.
